Ref: UNDP-TUR-RFP-PROJ(EGT)-2017/01**

On page 21, the required trade registry gazette and the Chamber of Commerce register in number 37 in Turkish. Is it sufficient to transmit these documents in Turkish or is it necessary to translate them into English and take the notary certifications?
Turkish documents are sufficient. UNDP reserves the right to request English translation of documents throughout the procurement process, if needed.
Should the proposers plan the trainings separately for each target group or a combined training is acceptable?
Yes, the trainings should be planned for each target group separately and the price proposals must be based on this. Any other approach such as combined training should be considered as a side activity for which UNDP will not make any payment.
Can the educational materials be proposed in a form other than "printed" version?
The proposers must respond to technical requirements stipulated in the RFP. In this regard, "printed" version of the educational materials must be proposed and factored into financial proposals. Meanwhile, any other forms that the proposers plan may be presented as a side activity in the technical proposals, for which UNDP will not make any additional payment.
Can you please clarify the content and target audience of board game and videos?
The board game was already prototyped. The videos will be provided to the contractor. For the content please refer to the Section 2.C of the Terms of Reference in the RFP document. The target group for the board game is the high school students. The videos which are also associated with the question cards contain questions that can be asked to an engineer in a construction site and the player is expected to choose from the two options given in the video or on the question card.
What are the number of teachers, parents and students to whom the trainings will be delivered?
The trainings will be delivered to 120 students, 60 parents and 30 teachers in total for two high schools. Accordingly, all proposers are required to design their proposals based on these numbers and reflect to financial proposals.
