As stated in the responsibilities of the service provider, the service provider will serve as an independent third party monitor, and serve solely as an observer in support of UNDP-FFS implementation in Al-Mosul city. The service provider will receive from UNDP detailed information regarding projects, exact locations, implementing partners and beneficiaries' including the amount to be paid for each individual. The service provider is required to monitor all cash payments made to beneficiaries and conduct face-to-face verifications on a daily/weekly basis. Any observation should be reported immediately to UNDP focal points and it will be UNDP's responsibility to act as appropriate.
