Financial Assistance for Installation of Medium-Large Size Biogas System under the Energy NAMA Project (CFP/GEF/NAMA/2017/08)

Nationally Appropriate Mitigation Actions in the Energy Generation and End-Use Sectors in Sri Lanka is a United Nations Development Program (UNDP) project (Energy NAMA Project), which is funded by the Global Environmental Facility (GEF). The execution agency of the project is the Ministry of Power & Renewable Energy (MoPRE) while implementation agencies of the project are the Sri Lanka Sustainable Energy Authority and the Climate Change Secretariat. This project aims to reduce Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions by dissemination of 1,000 biogas systems among individuals and institutions in dairy and livestock, farms, residential, industrial, local government, hotels, factories, hospitals, and other commercial sub-sectors.

The project encourages directing organic waste for productive use by generating biogas (predominantly methane), which could be used for cooking, lighting and thermal applications etc., as a sustainable solution for organic waste management, and the slurry produced by the biogas system as an agricultural input. The project is operational in the **Central, Eastern, North-Western, Southern, and Uva Provinces**.

The Energy NAMA project intends to publish Call for Proposals from prospective individuals and institutions, who generate over 200 kg of organic solid waste per day (or 400 litres of organic liquid waste with over 10% of solid content in them) on average, and are confronted with a problem of proper organic waste management, and are interested in processing such waste using Biogas Technology in above five provinces. The project would provide a reimbursement grant of up to 30% (maximum of Rs. 500,000.00) of the total cost to the selected projects for establishing biogas systems to manage their organic waste.

Those who are interested in setting up a biogas system with a part-financial support from the Energy NAMA project are requested to send their proposals with copies of required documents for consideration..

The application guidelines and application forms can be either collected or downloaded from www.lk.undp.org (operations>procurement>procurement notices). All proposals must be clearly marked with (CFP/GEF/NAMA/2017/08) on the top left corner of the envelope. The deadline for the submission of the proposals is **27 October 2017, 3.00 p.m** and all proposals must be sealed and delivered or sent by registered post to the addresses below. All late proposals will be rejected.
