UNDP Lebanon Procurement Unit has received several questions regarding the subject Tendering Procedure. All questions received to-date are documented below with respective answers.

Questions and Answers		
1.	Q.	What geographical locations in Lebanon do you envisage providers having to go to as part of the project?
	A.	Answer: The studies are spread all over the Lebanese territory. Please refer to the attached Appendix A, where the areas and type of projects are specified.
2.	Q.	What would be the frequency and duration of trips to Lebanon you envisage providers have to make as part of this project?
	A.	Answer: Not specified, this depend on the methodology proposed.
3.	Q.	Do you have an indication of the available budget for this project?
	A.	Answer: We cannot share the available budget of this project, but the projects for which the firm is requested to prepare the feasibility study is between USD 1 million and USD 1.5 million as mentioned in the TOR.
4.	Q.	Could you please provide examples of interventions to be appraised? We can't seem to find appendix A on the website.
	A.	Answer: Document posted on the related websites.

5.	Q.	We have downloaded the RFP for the reference procurement, however, we are missing Annex 4 (Terms of Reference). Could you please share those with us.
	A.	Answer: Document posted on the related websites.
6.	Q.	In reference to the below mentioned Request for Proposal no. LEB/CO/RFP/169/17, we have noticed that there is not any mention to the number of the projects that should be appraised by the expert during the contractual period, additionally, if there is any required pricing approach to be considered either by project or by expected working hours to carry out the project(s). It would be appreciated if you can clarify these two points in order to proceed in preparing our proposal on a clear basis.
	A.	Answer: The number of projects is 12 with a possibility of an increase or decrease of 25%. This means between a minimum of 9 and a maximum of 15 projects. Please refer to Annex 2 of the RFP points D&E.
