Construction of Prefabricated Pharmaceutical Storage Units in Zambia.

Minutes of Pre-bid meeting held at 10:00am on 4 October 2017 at Ministry of Health PMU

Introductory Remarks:

Participants were welcomed and given the opportunity to introduce themselves.

Participants were advised that the agenda of the meeting was to provide clarifications relating to invitation to bid for the Construction of Prefabricated Pharmaceutical Storage Units in Zambia.

Participants were encouraged to ask as many questions as possible ahead of their submissions and further told that the minutes will be shared on the UNDP cooperate website.

1. Matters Discussed

The background to the construction of prefab district stores in Zambia to be operated by the District Medical Officers of the MoH was shared.

It was noted that from the previous advert July 2017, 3 bids were received and all the 3 were found to be non-responsive. As such the procurement has to be re-tendered re-advertised, taking into consideration comments received from other potential bidders.

The re-advertised invitation to bid (ITB) was split into 4 lots based on geographical location.

Bidders are allowed, at their option, to bid for individual lots or for any combination of lots, but in each case bidders must quote for all (100%) the items and in the quantities specified in each lot. Bids not quoting for all (100%) items and in the quantities specified in a lot will be considered as non-responsive.

Participants were informed that full details pertaining to the invitation to bid will be posted on the UNDP corporate website.

Participants were advised as follows:

- Bidders needed to conform to the requirements in the ITB document for administrative, technical and financial requirements. A failure to comply with these requirements may lead to disqualification.
- The tender process will be governed by UNDP procurement principles of fairness, integrity and transparency.

- The 3 Phases involved in the evaluation process would be Preliminary evaluation, technical and financial, including post qualification requirements.
- The project is time bound and was expected to be completed by end of February 2018. Late submissions will not be accepted and as such, participants were advised to prepare their submissions early to avoid late bids.

2. Project Requirement (Questions and Answers Session)

A thorough explanation of the project requirements under the ITB for construction of prefab district stores in Zambia was presented to the participants.

6	Performance Security from insurance or from bank?	Bank security will be required for performance. No bid security is required.
7	Evaluation criteria	The 3 Phases involved in the evaluation process – Preliminary evaluation, technical and financial after including post qualifications requirements. Evaluation criteria in bid doc will not be altered.

(e.g. Kazungula – Bidders must bid for all the civil and supply works for this location). A bid will be considered incomplete if only the supply part is priced without pricing the
