

# REQUEST FOR INFORMATION-07/2017 (RFI-07/2017) FROM CSO/NGO

#### 1. OBJECTIVE

This is a Request for Information (RFI) from national and/or international CSOs/NGOs for potential partnership with UNDP in delivering outputs for development projects requiring expertise and experience in the following area:

## Promotion of Government-civil society dialogue on climate and gender-responsive budgeting in Cambodia

- Provide training and mentoring services to civil society organizations on the national budget process and climate-responsive budgeting;
- Design and manage outreach activities to promote better engagement of civil society in the budget process, specifically on climate change issues and including a gender and human rights lens;
- Organize the collection of evidence-based inputs on the climate change response from civil society, and include this evidence and recommendations in Government-civil society budget dialogue;

Key qualifications needed to be demonstrated with the documents submitted are the following:

- Proven capacity to mobilize and coordinate relevant civil society organizations for advocacy on national budget issues, climate change, gender, and human rights;
- Documented experience engaging constructively with Government and Parliament on national budget issues, including through organizations of forums, production of analysis / advocacy documents;
- Experience managing projects supported by international development partners.

Interested CSOs/NGOs are requested to fill out the below questionnaire, attaching all supporting documentation where specifically requested. If you are an international NGO, please provide information and documentation relating to your permits and licenses for your local presence in this country.

Extraneous information that are not directly responding to the questions will only constrain the ability of UNDP to positively assess the CSO/NGO's alignment with UNDP requirements.

All CSOs/NGOs whose information are found to be consistent with UNDP programme needs will be

sent a subsequent questionnaire to enable UNDP to conduct a Capacity Assessment. Based on the results of this Capacity Assessment Checklist (CACHE), UNDP will determine if the CSO/NGO may or may not be placed on a roster, for rapid engagement when required.
