Site visit with the contractors Masri Livestock on November 6, 2017.

Site visit procedure:

- 1. Met the contractors at the beneficiary's entrance and discussed the overall project design and the beneficiary's main activities
- 2. Visited the cattle farm
- 3. Visited the exact site location (biogas digester and CHP engine) and discussed the technical specifications
- 4. Visited the existing mechanical separator and the mixing pit
- 5. Discussed technical issues and questions with the contractors

Main points discussed (with the presence of the beneficiary representative):

- 1. Overview on the handling of the manure and transportation to the biogas facility of liquid manure, there was a discussion about 2 options: (1) piping system + pump from the old mixing pit to the digester; (2) the construction of new mixing pits and a new mechanical separator next to the biogas facility.
- 2. The distance of the cable to the main distribution board (new distance was approximated at 320 m (10% margin))
- 3. No hot water available at the new location.
- 4. Site preparation is the responsibility of the beneficiary, this includes tree removal, road preparation and fence construction.
- 5. Heating of the digester was put in question, contractors argued that with no insulation the heating will be obsolete, risk of losing 1 month a year of electricity generation.
- 6. Discussed the addition of a new pump that will pump the effluent to the new mechanical separator.
- 7. All above discussed points and request for CAD drawings are to be sent as clarification requests to procurement on: lb.bidding@undp.org
