Q1; Regarding **Electric Articulated Narrow Aisle Stackers**, please can you provide the detailed drawings of the storage racks in your warehouse?

A1; Relevant drawings attached as most sites are the same specification as Masvingo.

Q2; Regarding **Electric Articulated Narrow Aisle Stackers**, please kindly advise whether you need it to be Mechanical Guidance or Inductive Guidance?

A2. No guidance required

Q3. Please kindly confirm whether the RF Equipment supplier will be responsible of installation?

A3. Confirmed.

Q4. Please kindly provide detailed information about the RF Equipment. (e.g. Voltage etc.)

A4. 24 volt tapping off the battery.

Q5. Could you give us any pictures for the Electric Articulated Narrow Aisle Stackers, or you can give us any website links to show this equipment, thank you. If no pictures or website links, please give us more details to describe it's function.

A5. You will need to go into websites in UK and Ireland, some brand names are Bendi and Aisle Master but there are more.

Q6. For Electric Man Rider Pallet Jacks, what do you mean by “Receptacle for scan gun”?

A6. This is an holster for an scan gun. This will be supplied by others, the bidder only need to fix it to the PPT.

Q7. For “Electric Reach Trucks, what do you mean of “Details of fixture and power supply capability for RF data communication equipment”?

A7. A vehicle mounted scanner will need fixing to the truck and an 24v tapping from the battery.

Q8. For the quantity in ITB Page 27-28 and Page 48: in Page 27, the quantity is 9 or 10 for the Electric Articulated Narrow Aisle Stackers, and in Page 28, the quantity is 3 for the Electric Reach Trucks, but in Page 48, the 4 kinds lift equipment's is 9,3,2,2. Please clarify which one is the correct

A8. All are correct, there are four different types of equipment. Please bid for all.

Q9. For Local representative, do you need the representatives in three countries of Zambia, Zimbabwe and Guinea Bissau? Or in Copenhagen?

A9. In the country of delivery of equipment.
