

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) FROM CSO/NGO for Strenthening Women's Ability for Productive New Opportunities (SWAPNO)

1. OBJECTIVE

This is a Request for Information (RFI) from national CSOs/NGOs for potential partnership with UNDP to assist the implementation of the SWAPNO project through Local Government Institutions in 72 Union Parishads of Kurigram district and in 52 Union Parishads of Satkhira district of Bangladesh.

CSOs/NGOs will play a very important role in assisting the Union Parishads (UPs) to implement the SWAPNO project in accordance to the project operational guidelines. The NGOs will be involved in capacity development of UPs and the women beneficiaries selected from among extreme poor women, community mobilisation and monitoring of the planned activities. The NGOs will also organise training courses for the women beneficiaries, facilitate linkages between women, service providers, NGOs and the market, and counsel and monitor women engaged in income generating activities.

2. INFORMATION REQUESTED

Interested CSOs/NGOs are requested to fill out the two forms (Annex I- RFI Questioner and Annex II CACHE), attaching all supporting documentation where specifically requested.

Please note that attachments should be provided to support each answer to the questions. All questions must be answered directly and clearly. Extraneous information that are not directly responding to the questions will only constrain the ability of UNDP to positively assess the CSO/NGO's alignment with UNDP requirements.

CSOs/NGOs shall submit the questioners into two envelops labeled by the name of Organization and description of questioner (RFI and CACHE). Evaluation will be in two stages. Start by RFI followed by CACHE

All CSOs/NGOs whose information are found to be consistent with UNDP programme needs will be considered for Capacity Assessment. Based on the results of this Capacity Assessment Checklist (CACHE), UNDP will determine if the CSO/NGO may or may not be placed on a roster, for rapid engagement when required.
