Please advise if custom duty will be applicable to consignment.	<ol> <li>All the locations of PHCCs are currently stable and secured and UNDP officers and focal persons related to this case will provide support to deliver the medical equipment to the end user locations. But the supplier will be fully responsible for the delivery, offloading and installation.</li> <li>Regarding the custom duty, the supplier is fully responsible for custom clearance and any other issues related to it taking into consideration that UNDP will only be able to provide exemption approval that will take 3-6 weeks to be issued after the supplier submit all the required documents (invoice, packing list, certificate of origin and other forms).</li> </ol>
2.	As I understand, if we wait for custom duty exemption it will ultimately delay our payment.  Will we get paid 100% on delivery/ installation? Mode of payment will it be by bankers draft / Travellers Cheque / Account transfer?	Yes; according to payment terms in page 2 of the tender documents "100% upon complete delivery and installation of medical equipment to all the 8 PHCs" and mode of payment is EFT (electronic fund transfer).
