I. Project Background

The objective of the proposed project is to enhance sustainable land and forest management in the NE Armenia to secure continued flow of multiple ecosystem services. In particular, it aims at implementation of two components that are aimed at addressing the barriers of inadequate planning, regulatory and institutional framework for integrated forest resource management, and the limited experience among key government and civil society stakeholders in developing and implementing SFM practices on the ground.

To achieve planned outcomes, the project strategy is to address the barriers described through a coherent combination of corresponding incremental outputs organized into two components/ outcomes, the first one focusing on developing an enabling environment to plan, monitor and adapt sustainable forest and land management that will facilitate incorporation of sustainable forest, land and environmental management objectives and safeguards in forest management planning, forest land allocation and management and compliance monitoring systems at the local level. The second component will help in piloting the implementation of sustainable forest management and ecosystem rehabilitation practices in the eleven forest enterprise branches covering 220,000 ha in Northeastern Armenia as a means to change the way the fundamentals of forest management are undertaken so as to derive multiple forest benefits of biodiversity conservation, carbon improvement, water retention and erosion prevention, grazing management, sustainable community non-timber forest resource use and timber production.

The main objective of the project is to demonstrate a model of sustainable management of natural resources in mountain pastures and forests in Armenia which will enhance the carbon sequestration ability of ecosystems under climate change conditions, at the same time preserving biodiversity and economic values.

II. Scope of Work

The objective of the task is

Implementation of the following forest rehabilitation activities in the territory of Ijevan Forest Enterprise of Hayantar SNCO of Tavush marz: (a) Coppicing of logged oak-hornbeam forests – 30 ha and (b) Support to natural regrowth (mostly in the hazel grove) – 300 ha.

The scope of the services

- (a) Coppicing of logged oak-hornbeam forests 30 ha
 - 1. Land survey of the 30ha pre-defined area of logged oak-hornbeam coppice forest in the territory of Ijevan Forest Enterprise of "Hayantar" SNCO in RA Tavush marz envisaged for rehabilitation through coppicing, prepare appropriate GIS maps and calculate the approximate amount of branches/offshoots to be removed (firewood);
 - 2. Submit the methodology and technical design of the work to be done (coppicing), as well as cost estimates and timeline;
 - 3. Submit a certificate about the environmental impact assessment of the draft of the work to support coppicing as per the "Law of the RA on Environmental Impact Assessment and Expertise;"
 - 4. Implement activities toward coppicing in oak-hornbeam forests:
 - Leave 2-3 well-developed and relatively straight branches/offshoots, and chop off
 the rest. Remove the chopped offshoots and branches from the forest and store
 them in appropriate location;
 - During the work, pay special attention to rare and endangered plant species under protection which are included in the Red Book of Armenia;
 - Involve the members of the local communities in the forest rehabilitation work and conduct relevant trainings in advance;
 - Hand over the fuelwood generated as a result of coppicing to the Ijevan Forest Enterprise of "Hayantar" SNCO, to be distributed among the distressed families in forest-adjacent communities. The fuelwood will be distributed among the families determined by the heads of the communities; in case of excess, it will be distributed among the population of the communities included in the list approved by the joint decrees of the RA Minister of Agriculture (No 227-A, dated 29 November 2011) RA Minister of Nature Protection (No 254-A dated 29 November 2011), and RA Minister of Territorial Administration (No 144-A dated 30 November 2011).
 - (b) Support to natural regrowth (mainly in the hazel grove) 300 ha
 - 1. Removal of the litter;
 - 2. Soil mineralization up to 8 cm with 1X1 platforms and/or tranches;
 - 3. Sowing of seeds and their cultivation.
