Is the CRC component of the activities intended to be coordination with a 3rd party running the centre? Or would the successful partner on this project be required to be also directly managing at CRC in the area of implementation	The successful partner will be expected to work with a 3 rd party operating the CRC (for those areas in which CRCs exist). For areas in which there are community centers (not CRCs), there should also be close coordination with the relevant party/ies managing the community center. It is expected that activities, such as town hall meetings, community based discussions and social cohesion/peacebuilding activities are conducted from these centers as much as possible.
Is the deadline of June 25 still valid given the extended Eid break?	The deadline will be extended to 30 th June 2018, 7:00 AM New York Time (14:00 Baghdad time)
On the RFP there are 5 outputs specified - would we need to cover all outputs in the RFP and would we also need to cover all minimum activities under these outputs?	Proposals should aim to cover all Outputs and All minimum activities listed under the Outputs as they outputs and activities are deemed to be mutually reinforcing and will create multipliers from the assistance delivered under the Project. Notwithstanding the following is more specific advice regarding what outputs and activities must be covered in the submission. The following outputs and all the activities listed must be included in the submission: Output 1, 4 and 5 Output 3 activities 1 to 8 and 12 to 14 should be included in the proposal. If the creation of a village savings and loans association is deemed necessary and feasible, this should also be considered. Output 2 is optional; however hazard mapping would strengthen the community assessment and planning process that has already been conducted

Is partnership with local organizations a pre- requisite, or can we establish the handover procedure during the project implementation?	Partners with local organizations are encouraged; however, time constraints prevent the finalization of such partnerships, the plan for capacity building of local partner/s and project handover to a local organization can be included in the implementation plan.
