A two-stage procedure is utilized in evaluating the submissions, with evaluation of the technical components being completed prior to any price proposals being opened and compared. The price proposal will be opened only for submissions that passed the minimum technical score of 70% of the obtainable score of 1000 points in the evaluation of the technical component.

The technical component is evaluated on the basis of its responsiveness to the Term of Reference (TOR).

Maximum 1000 points will be given to the lowest offer and the other financial proposals will receive the points inversely proportional to their financial offers. i.e. $Sf = 1000 \times Fm / F$, in which Sf is the financial score, Fm is the lowest price and F the price of the submission under consideration.

The weight of technical points is 70% and financial points is 30%. Submission obtaining the highest weighted points (technical points + financial points) will be selected.

Interview with the candidates may be held if deemed necessary.

I. BACKGROUND

Viet Nam is one of the first countries engaged in REDD+, through its participation in the UN-REDD Programme, the World Bank FCPF, and numerous REDD+ initiatives. With technical support from UN agencies and development partners, Viet Nam has developed basic foundation for REDD+ implementation, of which the National REDD+ Strategy so-called National REDD+ Action Programme (NRAP) as requested by UNFCCC Decision 1/CP.16 was firstly was approved by the Prime Minister on 27th June, 2012 the for the period of 2011-2020. Over the last four years, the context has changed tremendously, both at the national as well as international level. As a result, in April 2017, the Prime Minister approved the National Program on reduction of greenhouse gas emissions through the mitigation of deforestation and forest degradation; conservation and enhancement of forest carbon stocks and sustainable management of forest resources through 2030 (hereinafter referred to as the NRAP) under the Decision No. 419/QD-TTg dated on the 5th, April 2017.

To implement the Prime Minister's decision No. 419/QD-TTg, the Midterm implementation plan of the NRAP in the period from 2018-2020 (NRIP) has been darfted and been expected to complete in June, 2018. During the implemention of the NRIP, the development of an inter-sectoral balance sheet (I/O) to determine the role of the agricultural sector in general and forest subsector in gross domestic product (GDP) as well as the spillover effects of implementing PAMs in the NRAP is quite important, especially providing rationales for mobilizing resources for sustainable forest development. The IO sheet will demonstrate the role of the sector as well as its efficient points to provide policy intervention.

Within the component 1 of the UN-REDD Viet Nam Programme phase II, Activity 1.1.7 and Activity 1.5.7 will support the implementation of policies and measures under NRAP 1.1 and 2.3 on integrated planning and interdisciplinary planning according to prioritized activities which have been identified when preparing the REDD+ investment plan (including the determination of the forestry contribution to GDP), this ToR is developed to call for two national consultants to provide technical expertise to achieve the following objectives and expectation.

II. SCOPE OF ASSIGNMENT

1. <u>Objectives</u>

To determine contributions from the forestry sector into the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and the added value of the forestry sub-sector (forest extraction, forest plantation and management, forest services and other timber and NTPs collected from the forest) in agriculture (crop production, forestry and fisheries); and to assess possible spillover effects of implementing some programs in NRIP in the changes in sector's contributions.

2. <u>Specific objectives</u>

- Developing the inter-sectoral input-output table (I/O) to determine the role and contributions of the forestry sub-sector in gross domestic product (GDP) and develop a scenario for 2020;
- Identifying the added value contributions from the forestry sector in the total value of agricultural sector (crop production, forestry and fisheries);
- Assessing possible spillover effects of implementing some REDD+ measures planed in the NRIP on forestry sector's contributions (scenario analysis with the assumptions of certain targets in NRIP being achieved);
- Proposing mechanisms and policy recommendations for implementation of PAMs in NRAP and NRIP sustainably the forestry sector;

3. <u>Main assignments</u>

Establishing the input-output (IO) table to identify the role and contribution of the forestry sub-sector into the gross domestic product; identifying the added value contribution of the forestry sub-sector in agriculture sector (crop production, forestry and fisheries); and assessing possible spillover effects of achieving some targets of the programs/PAMs in the NRAP and the NRIP (2018-2020) implementation.

+ Developing the input-output table (I/O) to identify the role of the forestry sector in gross domestic product;

+ Analyzing the added value of the forestry sector in agriculture, forestry and fisheries;

- + Designing tools for surveying and evaluating;
- + Organizing field surveys, entering and analyzing data from field surveys;

+ Doing secnario analysis to see the sector contribution changes given the conditions of some programs and PAMs implemented

+ Writing a synthesized report and a report proposing policy mechanisms to promote the implementation of REDD+ measures to enhance the added value and to develop sustainably the forestry sector;

+ Organizing the expert consultation workshops;

4. <u>Expected outputs</u>

The consultants will work in a team under the leadership of the team leader to deliver the joint product as follow

Output 1: An Input-Output table identifying the contribution of the forestry sub-sector to the gross domestic product (GDP) with the base of 2016;

Output 2: Report on the value added of the forestry sector in the value-added of agriculture sector (crop production, forestry and fisheries);

Output 3: results of scenario analysis to evaluate the spill-over effects of implementing some PAMs/programs in NRAP and/NRIP on the change of forest sector's contributions to GDP

Output 4: A set of policy recommendations for effective implementation of Midterm NRIP/NRAP to enhance the value added and sustainable development of the forestry sector.

IV. TIME, LOCATION AND SUPERVISION

- Time: Each consultant is expected to work for about 45 days over the period of July to Oct., 2018.
