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GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

FOR THE SERVICES OF INDIVIDUAL CONTRACTORS



LEGAL STATUS: The Individual contractor shall have the legal status of an dependent contractor vis-à-vis the United Nations Development Programme INDP), and shall not be regarded, for any purposes, as being either a "staff ember" of UNDP, under the UN' Staff Regulations and Rules, or an "official" of NDP, for purposes of the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the nited Nations, adopted by the General Assembly of the United Nations on 13 bruary 1946. Accordingly, nothing within or relating to the Contract shall tablish the relationship of employer and employee, or of principal and sent, between UNDP and the Individual contractor. The officials, presentatives, employees or subcontractors of UNDP and of the Individual intractor, if any, shall not be considered in any respect as being the employees or sents of the other, and UNDP and the Individual contractor shall be solely sponsible for all claims arising out of or relating to its engagement of such prisons or entities.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT: In General: The Individual contractor shall either seek nor accept instructions from any authority external to UNDP in onnection with the performance of its obligations under the Contract. Should any ithority external to UNDP seek to impose any instructions on the Contract garding the Individual contractor's performance under the Contract, the dividual contractor shall promptly notify UNDP and shall provide all reasonable sistance required by UNDP. The Individual contractor shall not take any action respect of its performance of the Contract or otherwise related to its oligations under the Contract that may adversely affect the interests of UNDP, nd the Individual contractor shall perform its obligations under the Contract ith the fullest regard to the interests of UNDP. The Individual contractor arrants that it has not and shall not offer any direct or indirect benefit ising from or related to the performance of the Contract or the award thereof to by representative, official, employee or other agent of UNDP. The Individual intractor shall comply with all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations bearing on the performance of its obligations under the Contract. In the performance of e Contract the Individual contractor shall comply with the standards of conduct set in e Secretary General's Bulletin ST/SGB/2002/9 of 18 June 2002, entitled "Regulations overning the Status, Basic Rights and Duties of Officials other than Secretariat fficials, and Expert on Mission". The individual contractor must comply with all ecurity Directives issued by UNDP. Failure to comply with such security directives is ounds for termination of the Individual contractor for cause.

ohibition of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse: In the performance of the ontract, the Individual contractor shall comply with the standards of conduct to forth in the Secretary-General's bulletin ST/SGB/2003/13 of 9 October 103, concerning "Special measures for protection from sexual exploitation and exual abuse". In particular, the Individual contractor shall not engage in any onduct that would constitute sexual exploitation or sexual abuse, as defined that bulletin.

he Individual contractor acknowledges and agrees that any breach of any of the ovisions hereof shall constitute a breach of an essential term of the Contract, and, addition to any other legal rights or remedies available to any person, shall ve rise to grounds for termination of the Contract. In addition, nothing herein tall limit the right of UNDP to refer any alleged breach of the foregoing andards of conduct to the relevant national authorities for appropriate legal trion.

TITLE RIGHTS, COPYRIGHTS, PATENTS AND OTHER PROPRIETARY IGHTS: Title to any equipment and supplies that may be furnished by UNDP the Individual contractor for the performance of any obligations under the ontract shall rest with UNDP, and any such equipment shall be returned to NDP at the conclusion of the Contract or when no longer needed by the dividual contractor. Such equipment, when returned to UNDP, shall be in the me condition as when delivered to the Individual contractor, subject to normal ear and tear, and the Individual contractor shall be liable to compensate UNDP or any damage or degradation of the equipment that is beyond normal wear and

NDP shall be entitled to all intellectual property and other proprietary rights, cluding, but not limited to, patents, copyrights and trademarks, with gard to products, processes, inventions, ideas, know-how or documents and her materials which the Individual contractor has developed for UNDP under e Contract and which bear a direct relation to or are produced or prepared or ollected in consequence of, or during the course of, the performance of the ontract, and the Individual contractor acknowledges and agrees that such roducts, documents and other materials constitute works made for hire or UNDP. However, to the extent that any such intellectual property or other oprietary rights consist of any intellectual property or other proprietary rights the Individual contractor: (a) that pre-existed the performance by the Individual

contractor of its obligations under the Contract, or (b) that the Individu contractor may develop or acquire, or may have developed or acquire independently of the performance of its obligations under the Contract, UNI does not and shall not claim any ownership interest thereto, and 1 Individual contractor grants to UNDP a perpetual licence to use su intellectual property or other proprietary right solely for the purposes of a in accordance with the requirements of the Contract. At the request of UNI the Individual contractor shall take all necessary steps, execute all necessary documents and generally assist in securing such proprietary rights a transferring or licensing them to UNDP in compliance with the requirement of the applicable law and of the Contract. Subject to the foregoing provisio all maps, drawings, photographs, mosaics, plans, reports, estimat recommendations, documents and all other data compiled by or received by Individual contractor under the Contract shall be the property of UNDP, shall made available for use or inspection by UNDP at reasonable times and reasonable places, shall be treated as confidential and shall be delivered only UNDP authorized officials on completion of work under the Contract

4 CONFIDENTIAL NATURE OF DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATIO Information and data that are considered proprietary by either UNDP or t Individual contractor or that are delivered or disclosed by one of the ("Discloser") to the other ("Recipient") during the course of performance the Contract, and that are designated as confidential ("Information"), shall held in confidence and shall be handled as follows. The Recipient of su Information shall use the same care and discretion to avoid disclosu publication or dissemination of the Discloser's Information as it uses with own similar information that it does not wish to disclose, publish disseminate, and the Recipient may otherwise use the Discloser's Informati solely for the purpose for which it was disclosed. The Recipient may disclo confidential Information to any other party with the Discloser's prior writt consent, as well as to the Recipient's employees, officials, representatives a agents who have a need to know such confidential Information solely purposes of performing obligations under the Contract. Subject to and without a waiver of the privileges and immunities of UNDP, the Individual contractor m disclose Information to the extent required by law, provided that the Individu contractor will give UNDP sufficient prior notice of a request for the disclosi of Information in order to allow UNDP to have a reasonable opportunity take protective measures or such other action as may be appropriate before ϵ such disclosure is made. UNDP may disclose Information to the extent required pursuant to the Charter of the United Nations, resolutions regulations of the General Assembly or its other governing bodies, or ru promulgated by the Secretary-General. The Recipient shall not be preclud from disclosing Information that is obtained by the Recipient from a third pa without restriction, is disclosed by the Discloser to a third party without a obligation of confidentiality, is previously known by the Recipient, or at any time developed by the Recipient completely independently of any disclosures hereund These obligations and restrictions of confidentiality shall be effective during 1 term of the Contract, including any extension thereof, and, unless otherw provided in the Contract, shall remain effective following any termination the Contract.

5. TRAVEL, MEDICAL CLEARANCE AND SERVICE INCURRED DEAT INJURY OR ILLNESS: If the Individual contractor is required by UNDP travel beyond commuting distance from the Individual contractor's usual pla of residence, and upon prior written agreement, such travel shall be at t expense of UNDP. Such travel shall be at economy care when by air. UNDP may require the Individual contractor to submit a Statement of Go Health from a recognized physician prior to commencement of work in any offic or premises of UNDP or before engaging in any travel required by UNDP connected with the performance of the Contract. The Individual contractor sh provide such a Statement of Good Health as soon as practicable followi such request, and prior to engaging in any such travel, and i Individual contractor warrants the accuracy of Stateme anv such including, but not limited to, confirmation that the Individual contractor I been fully informed regarding the requirements for inoculations for the coun or countries to which travel may be authorized.

In the event of the death, injury or illness of the Individual contractor which attributable to the performance of services on behalf of UNDP under the terms the Contract while the Individual contractor is traveling at UNDP expense or performing any services under the Contract in any offices or premises of UNE the Individual contractor or the Individual contractor's dependants, as appropria shall be entitled to compensation equivalent to that provided under the UNI insurance policy, available upon request.



PROHIBITION ON ASSIGNMENT; MODIFICATIONS: The Individual ntractor may not assign, delegate, transfer, pledge or make any other sposition of the Contract, of any part thereof, or of any of the rights, claims obligations under the Contract except with the prior written authorization of NDP, and any attempt to do so shall be null and void. The terms or nditions of any supplemental undertakings, licences or other forms of intract concerning any goods or services to be provided under the Contract all not be valid and enforceable against UNDP nor in any way shall constitute an intract by UNDP thereto, unless any such undertakings, licences or other forms. Contract are the subject of a valid written undertaking by UNDP. No odification or change in the Contract shall be valid and enforceable against NDP unless provided by means of a valid written amendment to the Contract gned by the Individual contractor and an authorized official or appropriate intracting authority of UNDP.

SUBCONTRACTORS: In the event that the Individual contractor requires the rvices of subcontractors to perform any obligations under the Contract, the dividual contractor shall obtain the prior written approval of UNDP for any ch subcontractors. UNDP may, in its sole discretion, reject any proposed 1bcontractor or require such subcontractor's removal without having to give 1y justification therefore, and such rejection shall not entitle the Individual intractor to claim any delays in the performance, or to assert any excuses for e non-performance, of any of its obligations under the Contract. The Individual intractor shall be solely responsible for all services and obligations performed by 3 subcontractors. The terms of any subcontract shall be subject to, and shall be instrued in a manner that is fully in accordance with, all of the terms and inditions of the Contract.

USE OF NAME, EMBLEM OR OFFICIAL SEAL OF THE UNITED ATIONS: The Individual contractor shall not advertise or otherwise make iblic for purposes of commercial advantage or goodwill that it has a contractual lationship with UNDP, nor shall the Individual contractor, in any manner hatsoever, use the name, emblem or official seal of UNDP, or any abbreviation of e name of UNDP, in connection with its business or otherwise without the written emission of UNDP.

INDEMNIFICATION: The Individual contractor shall indemnify, defend, and old and save harmless UNDP, and its officials, agents and employees, from a dagainst all suits, proceedings, claims, demands, losses and liability of any nd or nature, including, but not limited to, all litigation costs and expenses, torney's fees, settlement payments and damages, based on, arising from, or lating to: (a) allegations or claims that the use by UNDP of any patented vice, any copyrighted material or any other goods or services provided to UNDP or its use under the terms of the Contract, in whole or in part, separately or in mbination, constitutes an infringement of any patent, copyright, trademark or her intellectual property right of any third party; or (b) any acts or omissions of e Individual contractor, or of any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly nployed by them in the performance of the Contract, which give rise to legal ability to anyone not a party to the Contract, including, without limitation, aims and liability in the nature of a claim for workers' compensation.

). INSURANCE: The Individual contractor shall pay UNDP promptly for all loss, estruction or damage to the property of UNDP caused by the Individual ontractor, or of any subcontractor, or anyone directly or indirectly employed them in the performance of the Contract. The Individual contractor shall solely responsible for taking out and for maintaining adequate insurance quired to meet any of its obligations under the Contract, as well as for ranging, at the Individual contractor 's sole expense, such life, health and other rms of insurance as the Individual contractor may consider to be appropriate to wer the period during which the Individual contractor provides services under the insurance arrangements the Individual contractor may make shall, in the insurance arrangements the Individual contractor is liability arising under or relating to the Contract.

LENCUMBRANCES AND LIENS: The Individual contractor shall not cause or rmit any lien, attachment or other encumbrance by any person to be placed on le or to remain on file in any public office or on file with UNDP against any onies due to the Individual contractor or to become due for any work donor or gainst any goods supplied or materials furnished under the Contract, or by ason of any other claim or demand against the Individual contractor.

2. FORCE MAJEURE; OTHER CHANGES IN CONDITIONS: In the event and as soon as possible after the occurrence of any cause constituting rce majeure, the Individual contractor shall give notice and full particulars in riting to UNDP of such occurrence or cause if the Individual contractor is ereby rendered unable, wholly or in part, to perform its obligations and meet its sponsibilities under the Contract. The Individual contractor shall also notify NDP of any other changes in conditions or the occurrence of any event, hich interferes or threatens to interfere with its performance of the Contract, ot more than fifteen (15) days following the provision of such notice of force ajeure or other changes in conditions or occurrence, the Individual contractor tall also submit a statement to UNDP of estimated expenditures that will likely be

incurred for the duration of the change in conditions or the event. On receipt the notice or notices required hereunder, UNDP shall take such action as considers, in its sole discretion, to be appropriate or necessary in the circumstances, including the granting to the Individual contractor of reasonable extension of time in which to perform any obligations under the Contract.

In the event of and as soon as possible after the occurrence of any cat constituting force majeure, the Individual contractor shall give notice and f particulars in writing to UNDP of such occurrence or cause if the Individu contractor is thereby rendered unable, wholly or in part, to perform its obligation and meet its responsibilities under the Contract. The Individual contractor sh also notify UNDP of any other changes in conditions or the occurrence of a event, which interferes or threatens to interfere with its performance of 1 Contract. Not more than fifteen (15) days following the provision of such not of force majeure or other changes in conditions or occurrence, the Individual contractor shall also submit a statement to UNDP of estimated expenditures tl will likely be incurred for the duration of the change in conditions or the eve On receipt of the notice or notices required hereunder, UNDP shall take su action as it considers, in its sole discretion, to be appropriate or necessary in the circumstances, including the granting to the Individual contractor a reasonable extension of time in which to perform any obligations under 1 Contract.

Force majeure as used herein means any unforeseeable and irresistible act nature, any act of war (whether declared or not), invasion, revolutions insurrection, or any other acts of a similar nature or force, provided that subjects arise from causes beyond the control and without the fault or negliger of the Individual contractor. The Individual contractor acknowledges and agree that, with respect to any obligations under the Contract that the Individual contractor must perform in or for any areas in which UNDP is engage in, preparing to engage in, or disengaging from any peacekeepin humanitarian or similar operations, any delay or failure to perform such obligations arising from or relating to harsh conditions within such areas or to any incide of civil unrest occurring in such areas shall not, in and of itself, constitute for majeure under the Contract

13. TERMINATION: Either party may terminate the Contract, in whole or in pa upon giving written notice to the other party. The period of notice shall be five (5) da in the case of Contracts for a total period of less than two (2) months and fourteen (1 days in the case of contracts for a longer period. The initiation of conciliation or arbit proceedings, as provided below, shall not be deemed to be a "cause" for or otherwise be in itself a termination of the Contract. UNDP may, without prejudice to any otl right or remedy available to it, terminate the Contract forthwith in the event that: (a) Individual contractor is adjudged bankrupt, or is liquidated, or becomes insolve applies for moratorium or stay on any payment or repayment obligations, or applies be declared insolvent; (b) the Individual contractor is granted a moratorium or a stay is declared insolvent; the Individual contractor makes an assignment for the benefit one or more of its creditors; (c) a Receiver is appointed on account of the insolvency the Individual contractor; (d) the Individual contractor offers a settlement in lieu bankruptcy or receivership; or (e) UNDP reasonably determines that the Individu contractor has become subject to a materially adverse change in its financial conditi that threatens to endanger or otherwise substantially affect the ability of the Individu contractor to perform any of its obligations under the Contract.

In the event of any termination of the Contract, upon receipt of notice of termination UNDP, the Individual contractor shall, except as may be directed by UNDP in 1 notice of termination or otherwise in writing: (a) take immediate steps to bring 1 performance of any obligations under the Contract to a close in a prompt and orde manner, and in doing so, reduce expenses to a minimum: (b) refrain from undertaki any further or additional commitments under the Contract as of and following the d of receipt of such notice; (c) deliver all completed or partially completed pla drawings, information and other property that, if the Contract had been complete would be required to be furnished to UNDP thereunder; (d) complete performance the work not terminated; and (e) take any other action that may be necessary, or the UNDP may direct in writing, for the protection and preservation of any proper whether tangible or intangible, related to the Contract that is in the possession of the Individual contractor and in which UNDP has or may be reasonably expected to acquain interest.

In the event of any termination of the Contract, UNDP shall only be liable to pay I Individual contractor compensation on a pro rata basis for no more than the acti amount of work performed to the satisfaction of UNDP in accordance with I requirements of the Contract. Additional costs incurred by UNDP resulting from I termination of the Contract by the Individual contractor may be withheld from a amount otherwise due to the Individual contractor from UNDP...

14. NON-EXCLUSIVITY: UNDP shall have no obligation respecting, and limitations on, its right to obtain goods of the same kind, quality and quanti or to obtain any services of the kind described in the Contract, from any otl source at any time.

15. TAXATION: Article II, section 7, of the Convention on the Privileges a Immunities of the United Nations provides, *inter alia*, that the United Natio

luding its subsidiary organs, is exempt from all direct taxes, except charges for blic utility services, and is exempt from customs restrictions, duties and arges of a similar nature in respect of articles imported or exported for its icial use. In the event any governmental authority refuses to United Nations from such taxes, ognize the exemptions of the trictions, duties or charges, the Individual contractor shall immediately nsult with UNDP to determine a mutually acceptable procedure. UNDP all have no liability for taxes, duties or other similar charges payable by the lividual contractor in respect of any amounts paid to the Individual contractor der this Contract, and the Individual contractor acknowledges that UNDP will t issue any statements of earnings to the Individual contractor in respect of any ch payments.

AUDITS AND INVESTIGATIONS:

ich invoice paid by UNDP shall be subject to a post-payment audit by auditors, nether internal or external, of UNDP or by other authorized and qualified agents of NDP at any time during the term of the Contract and for a period of two (2) years llowing the expiration or prior termination of the Contract. UNDP shall be entitled to refund from the Individual contractor for any amounts shown by such audits to have en paid by UNDP other than in accordance with the terms and conditions of the ontract.

ne Individual contractor acknowledges and agrees that, from time to time, UNDP may induct investigations relating to any aspect of the Contract or the award thereof, the oligations performed under the Contract, and the operations of the Individual intractor generally relating to performance of the Contract. The right of UNDP to induct an investigation and the Individual contractor's obligation to comply with such investigation shall not lapse upon expiration or prior termination of the Contract. ne Individual contractor shall provide its full and timely cooperation with any such spections, post-payment audits or investigations. Such cooperation shall include, but vall not be limited to, the Individual contractor's obligation to make available its ersonnel and any relevant documentation for such purposes at reasonable times and on asonable conditions and to grant to UNDP access to the Individual contractor's emises at reasonable times and on reasonable conditions in connection with such cess to the Individual contractor's personnel and relevant documentation. dividual contractor shall require its agents, including, but not limited to, the Individual intractor's attorneys, accountants or other advisers, to reasonably cooperate with any spections, post-payment audits or investigations carried out by UNDP hereunder.

7. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

MICABLE SETTLEMENT: UNDP and the Individual contractor shall use their est efforts to amicably settle any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of the ontract or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof. Where the parties wish seek such an amicable settlement through conciliation, the conciliation shall ke place in accordance with the Conciliation Rules then obtaining of the nited Nations Commission on International Trade Law ("UNCITRAL"), or cording to such other procedure as may be agreed between the parties in writing. RBITRATION: Any dispute, controversy or claim between the parties ising out of the Contract, or the breach, termination, or invalidity thereof, iless settled amicably, as provided above, shall be referred by either of the arties to arbitration in accordance with the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules en obtaining. The decisions of the arbitral tribunal shall be based on general inciples of international commercial law. For all evidentiary questions, the bitral tribunal shall be guided by the Supplementary Rules Governing the esentation and Reception of Evidence in International Commercial rbitration of the International Bar Association, 28 May 1983 edition. The bitral tribunal shall be empowered to order the return or destruction of goods or ly property, whether tangible or intangible, or of any confidential information ovided under the Contract, order the termination of the Contract, or order at any other protective measures be taken with respect to the goods, rvices or any other property, whether tangible or intangible, or of any infidential information provided under the Contract, as appropriate, all in cordance with the authority of the arbitral tribunal pursuant to Article 26 Interim Measures of Protection") and Article 32 ("Form and Effect of the Award") the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules. The arbitral tribunal shall have no ithority to award punitive damages. In addition, unless otherwise expressly ovided in the Contract, the arbitral tribunal shall have no authority to award terest in excess of the London Inter-Bank Offered Rate ("LIBOR") then evailing, and any such interest shall be simple interest only. The parties iall be bound by any arbitration award rendered as a result of such arbitration as e final adjudication of any such dispute, controversy or claim.

3. PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES: Nothing in or relating to the Contract iall be deemed a waiver, express or implied, of any of the privileges and munities of the United Nations, including its subsidiary organs.
