## I. Identifying Information

Task Title: Service on modeling and suppy the energy efficient light equipment for

street illumination of the Sevan peninsula, Gegharkunik region, Republic

Armenia

**Project Title:** "Green Urban Lighting" UNDP-GEF/00074869

Location: Yerevan, Republic of Armenia

#### II. Background

Wide-spread application of outdated and inefficient lighting technologies in the outdoor municipal lighting sector dominated mainly by low-quality high-pressure sodium and mercury-vapor street lamps and fixtures, leads to growth of operation and maintenance (replacement) costs of municipalities as well as increase of energy consumption and associated greenhouse gas emissions. This makes lighting the second largest source of municipal GHG emissions in Armenia after heating.

The overarching goal of the project is to save energy and to reduce emissions of greenhouse gases by increasing energy efficiency of municipal lighting in the cities of Armenia via implementation of municipal investment programs and national policies. To realize this objective, the proposed project will carry out a number of activities that will deliver specific outputs.

One of the major components of the Project envisages design and implementation of demonstration projects on energy-efficient public lighting in Yerevan and other selected urban areas aimed to demonstrate energy and cost saving benefits as well as reduction of greenhouse gases due to introduction of modern efficient lighting technologies. Along with the mentioned outcomes, pilot projects are expected to raise awareness of municipal decision-makers and general public on energy efficient lighting and contributes to promotion and replication of similar projects in the future.

Within the scope of the Project energy efficient upgrade of the existing inefficient lighting system of the streets will be realized in cooperation with «Sevan National Park» SNCO to demonstrate energy efficiency and environmental benefits of new lighting technologies.

## **III. Scope of Supply Services**

## **Objective of the Task**

The main objective of the task is to supply LED street luminaires. The supplied luminaries should provide illumination level required by the norms and must comply with technical requirements as described in Chapter IV below.

### **Activities per the Task**

Within the scope of services, supplier must implement the following activities and supply 65 LED luminaires:

- 1. Propose LED street luminaires for illumination of the demonstration street and pedestrian area (luminaires type1 and type2, see the Sketch 1);
- 2. Provide lighting design and calculation/estimation for the proposed LED street luminaries (calculation should be done on the base of maintenance factor **equal or equivalent 0.8**) in


condition 30m of distance between poles and on the basis of the technical requirements and street description (Sketch N1).

The calculations for the proposed luminaries must ensure conformity of calculated lighting level to the requirements according EN13201:2015 for roads classes M5 with CIE R3 class asphalt surface and for roads classes C5 or have to comply with below provided parameters:

- 3. Provide all respective certificates in accordance with the international requirements for the proposed LED street luminaries;
- 4. Provide detailed instruction on installation and maintenance of luminaries.

## IV. Specific Requirements to Equipment

1. Compliance with required parameters (see table below) should be confirmed by technical passport of luminaires and are mandatory.

- 2. Luminaries shall provide at least 100 lm/W light output ratio.
- 3. Supplier should ensure spare parts to remain available for the stated life of the luminaries.
- 4. Luminaries must meet the requirements of the following quality standards confirmed by the declaration of conformity:
  - EN 60598-1 Luminaries General requirements and tests
  - EN 60598-2-3 Luminaries for road and street lighting
  - EN 55015 Limits and methods of measurement of radio disturbance characteristics of electrical lighting and similar equipment
  - EN 61000-3-X Limits for harmonic current emissions
  - EN 61000-4-X Electromagnetic compatibility (EMC)
  - EN 61547 Equipment for general lighting purpose, immunity requirements
  - EN 62031 LED modules for general lighting Safety specifications
  - EN 62471 Photobiological safety of lamps and lamp systems
  - EN 60529 Degrees of protection provided by enclosures (IP Code)

## Other Requirements:

- 1. Optical parts of the luminaries should be made from thermally and shockproof materials, steady against ultra-violet radiation and providing operational durability.
- 2. Luminaries must have clear marks with information on model and its technical characteristics (as additional can be provided information on the model and country of origin of LEDs and driver).
- 3. Instructions and schemes for making connections shall be provided.
- 4. Luminaries must have an aesthetic appearance and modern design.

Luminaries should be convenient in service and provide modular assembly for components that are expected to be replaced in the field by tool-less operation.
