# **Background**

N-Peace (Engage for Peace, Equality, Access, Community and Empowerment) is a multi-country initiative managed by UNDP across Indonesia, Sri Lanka, Timor-Leste, Nepal, and more recently Afghanistan and the Philippines, in partnership with Search for Common Ground, the Institute for Inclusive Security and supported by AusAID.

N-Peace has two key objectives: (i) to support and promote the leadership of women as peace builders; and (ii) to provide a platform for engagement and dialogue between different stakeholders to promote the Women, Peace and Security (WPS) agenda and broader conflict prevention and peace building goals.

These two objectives are met through a range of activities, designed and implemented with network members, thereby adopting a strong community of practice approach, central to UNDP's vision as a knowledge-based organization. Through the N-Peace initiative, a regional campaign to support the leadership of peace builders is implemented. This campaign identifies, documents and showcases the work of peace builders in the six N-Peace countries, through two phases of receiving nominations and voting for N-peace awardees.

The purpose of this assignment is to provide editorial support to the nomination phase of the N-Peace awards campaign 2013<sup>1</sup>

Support the collection and consolidation of all nominations received for the three

nominators for images and profile information.
