QUESTION No. 1:	It is not clear if the consultant can add Key and/or Non-Key personnel to the bid, supported on the best approach and methodology, adding those time inputs to its offer. Can the consultant add other Experts, including their CV's, to the proposal?
REPLY No. 1:	Yes, the consultant may propose new capacities that will be considered under the evaluation process.
QUESTION No. 2:	In Page 3 under the Brief Description of the Required Services section, it is mentioned that the second phase proposed to continue support in "Linking the geo-mapping with an existing Management Information System (MIS- Al Murshed)". May you please send us the core software System package used in building the MIS and developing the GIS system (database, GIS desktop and web....).
REPLY No. 2:	Al Murshed is a MIS system built on SQL database supported with GIU, it is used as a platform for collecting data about students in East Jerusalem, reinforced with query and reporting system.
