ATTACHMENT-1- ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS FROM PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS

Question:

With reference to the assignment "Supervision services for Construction of Waste Water Treatment Plant in Hassa/Hatay", as per RFP documents, item 14.1, notarized copy of joint venture agreement is required with tender documents.

One of our joint venture members is an international company, who is not registered in Turkey. Hence, notarization procedure of the JV agreement becomes a very time taking event. Even the extended duration of the tender is not adequate for this procedure. We are wondering whether the original copy of JV agreement instead of notarized one can be acceptable by your side under these conditions.

Answer:

As per the "Instruction to Proposers" subclause 14.1 (i), the JV, Consortium or Association agreement shall be duly notarized and submitted with the proposal.

Please be informed that your proposal will be evaluated against all administrative requirements stipulated by the subject RFP without any exception.
