Q1	<p>a) It would be very useful if I could get a general understanding as to the anticipated specification of office &amp; accommodation units, whether it will be prefabricated panel units, ISO units or hard / concrete buildings?</p> <p>b) Have the buildings got any relation with the re-building of the existing ones due to their poor conservation state? Could you give us some more indications about the scope of works?</p> <p>c) If it is possible, we would like to get preliminary project information (no and storey of the buildings, total closed area, etc.) and/or estimated budget for the scope of the works?</p> <p>We would like to have more information about the project if possible in order to prepare our tender as good as we can.</p>	A1	The design is for new buildings on vacant land and will be of hard wall/concrete construction. We do not desire accommodation “units” to be hard wall/concrete construction. The architect has a free hand to design office space and/or accommodation that can fit on the land, maximising the area. More specifically, the architect will advise UNDP of what is possible given the size of the land. Note this is an Expression of Interest”. The full requirement will be detailed in the “Request for Proposal (RFP) Stage”.
Q2	In the EOI document, you detail the need of presenting several Administrative documents such as: Legal Status, Proof of tax registration & payment, Financial capacity (audited financial statements), Quality Assure Certification, etc. Most of these documents are available in UNGM for your consultation. Thus, my question is, if our company has got UNGM level 2 registration updated; can we avoid submitting these documents?	A2	No, all applicants must submit all the required documents to the dedicated bids email address as instructed in the EOI.
