The unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the supplier does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

After UNDP has identified the lowest price offer, UNDP reserves the right to award the contract based only on the prices of the goods in the event that the transportation cost (freight and insurance) is found to be higher than UNDP's own estimated cost if sourced from its own freight forwarder and insurance provider.

At any time during the validity of the quotation, no price variation due to escalation, inflation, fluctuation in exchange rates, or any other market factors shall be accepted by UNDP after it has received the quotation. At the time of award of Contract or Purchase Order, UNDP reserves the right to vary (increase or decrease) the quantity of services and/or goods, by up to a maximum twenty five per cent (25%) of the total offer, without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions.

Any Purchase Order that will be issued as a result of this RFQ shall be subject to the General Terms and Conditions attached hereto. The mere act of submission of a quotation implies that the vendor accepts without question the General Terms and Conditions of UNDP herein attached as Annex 3.

I. Identifying Information

Task Title:	Supply of trailer for mobile lighting laboratory
Project Title:	“Regulatory Framework to Promote Energy Efficiency in Countries of the Eurasian Economic Union” UNDP-RTF/00102117
Duration:	60 days
Location:	Yerevan, Republic of Armenia

II. Background

The overarching goal of the regional project is to reduce emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG) by promoting energy efficiency (EE) in the countries of the Eurasian Economic Union (EEU), namely Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan and Belarus, via strengthening the national systems for appliances EE standards.

One of the project's components envisages establishment and/or upgrade of testing laboratories, including mobile ones, to enable the assessment of compliance of street lighting projects to the standards and norms acting in the Republic of Armenia.

III. Objective of the Task

The main objective of the task is to supply trailer/travelling platform for mobile laboratory for street illumination measurement. The supplied equipment should correspond with technical requirements as described in Chapter IV below.

IV. Specific Requirements to Equipment

The trailer/traveling platform should be used to install lighting measuring equipment of mobile laboratory for street illumination measurement. The outline drawing of the trailer/traveling platform is attached given in the Annex 1 of the Technical Specifications.

Requirements towards track/travelling platform are as follows:

- The design of the trailer (platform) is welded or modular type with a length of any element not exceeding 1.5 m,
- Trailer components are produced of zinc-coated steel profile,
- Suspension is unsprung axial,
- The minimal length of the trailer is 4000 mm (from the rear bumper to the tow bar) with an option to reduce the length of the trailer to 3000 mm (due to the use of the split-type drawbar,
- The minimum distance from the axis of the trailer to the rear bumper is 1000 mm (see the drawing),
- The maximum distance from the top point of the rear bumper to the ground is 280 mm (see the drawing),
- The maximum distance from the top point of the wing to the ground is 600 mm (see the drawing),
- The material of the rear bumper is U-shaped profile with bores (see the drawing),
- The platform is to be manufactured with the framed structure without floor covering,
- A spare wheel must be included in the set,
- The trailer should be equipped with ball type hitch locking device with safety rope,
- The design of the trailer should include a support column for the drawbar,
- The registration plate illumination, tail lights and turn signals should be installed on the bumper in accordance with the acting national regulations for vehicles and trailers,

- The tail lights should be installed on the sidepiece of the trailer,
- The installation of a 7-pin socket for powering of tail lights, turn signals and registration plate illumination should be provided.

Warranty of 1 year and local after sale services should be provided.

V. Warranty, after sale services and the Key Expected Results

The supplier should provide all the documentation required for the state registration of the trailer in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Armenia.

The final result of the task shall be supply of trailer as per the technical requirements.
