No.	Question submitted by bidders	Answer by Technical and Procurement Teams
1	In case the security situation may not allow visits of the evaluation team to some of the governorates (as mentioned in the RFP), our concern will be the calculation of the transport costs and their inclusion in the financial proposal, as the budget may increase without having probably to use such transportation costs.	Referring to the ToR, the geographical coverage of ICRRP more than 60% is located in Kurdistan Region of Iraq (Erbil, Dohuk, Sulaymaniyah, and Halabja Governorates, Raparin and Garmiyah Administrations), which is relatively safe in term of security. In case considering other governorates (i.e. Diyala, Ninewa, Basra, Salah-al-Din) with a higher risk of security issue, the security cost may need to prudently be calculated.
2	The RFP indicates a maximum of 108 working days to be distributed among three key experts. Can we include an additional expert while respecting the total allocated number of days, since we may think about having a national expert for few days to collect data in the South of Iraq and particularly in Basra?	Conducting survey with beneficiaries as outlined in the ToR is one of example of proposed methodology. It entirely depends on Consultancy Firms.
