We however, have a query on the eligibility criteria of the bidders. Point-14 of Section-2 "Instruction to Bidders' at Page 8 mentions that the bidders can form an association for the proposal. However, in Section-4 'Evaluation Criteria' at Page 21 of the RFP document, it is mentioned that 'the bidder shall be based in Kabul, Afghanistan'. In view of this, we request you to please clarify whether an Indian consulting firm is eligible to bid for the assignment in association with an Afghan firm registered in Kabul.
