Any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price (obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity) shall be re-computed by UNDP. The unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the supplier does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

After UNDP has identified the lowest price offer, UNDP reserves the right to award the contract based only on the prices of the goods in the event that the transportation cost (freight and insurance) is found to be higher than UNDP's own estimated cost if sourced from its own freight forwarder and insurance provider.

At any time during the validity of the quotation, no price variation due to escalation, inflation, fluctuation in exchange rates, or any other market factors shall be accepted by UNDP after it has received the quotation. At the time of award of Contract or Purchase Order, UNDP reserves the right to vary (increase or decrease) the quantity of services and/or goods, by up to a maximum twenty-five per cent (25%) of the total offer, without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions.

Technical Specifications

WASTE COMPACTORS/BALERS

A compact waste baler for the baling of different kind of waste including waste for recycling such as cardboard, paper and plastic. The baler should incorporate ergonomic design features to ensure utmost usability, e.g. large feed aperture for easy loading. The baler should include sufficient baling twine or tape for at least one-year operation, minimum 3000 m.

Specifications: Waste Compactors /Baler

Stand: Fabricated from welded profile steel; galvanized.

Waste reduction: Depending on the kind of waste, the volume of the waste will be reduced for 66 % (2/3 Volume reduction) to 90%

Protection class: Designed for the in-house as well as outside operation

Included: One Baler trolley to aid the easy removal of the bale itself. Suitable for use with the offered baler, the trolley should be easy to manoeuvre to protect operator wellbeing. Suitable for use with bales of up to 75kg

Included: Baling twine/tape for one-year operation (at least 3000 m)

Technical requirements:

- Press force: about 3 to 5 tonnes
- Loading aperture (H x W x D) – about 500 x 700 x 500mm
- Bale weight – up to 60kg
- Bale dimensions – maximum 800 x 700 x 500mm, preferably smaller
- Cycle time – less than 30 seconds
- Noise – less than 75 decibels
- Machine weight – 230kg
- Power supply (kW-V-Hz) – >2kW-230V-50Hz
- Overall dimensions (H x W x D) – Less than 2000 x 1200 x 1000mm
- Baling twine/tape: Breaking strain >200 kg
