

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) FROM CSO/NGO

Civil Society Organisations working on Business and Human Rights in Asia-Pacific

1. OBJECTIVE

This is a Request for Information (RFI) from national and/or international CSOs/NGOs for potential partnership with UNDP in delivering outputs for development projects requiring expertise and experience in the following areas:

Civil Society Organizations working at the regional level or on cross-border issues in Asia and the Pacific region for at least 5 years with a strong and verifiable track record contributing to the advancement of the "Business and Human Rights agenda". The thematic areas of focus include, but are not limited to:

- Access to effective remedy through public interest litigation or legal aid, for human rights abuses and environmental rights abuses connected to business operations;
- Raising awareness through targeted training of journalists on transboundary environmental issues, international trade and investment, special economic zones, infrastructure development as they relate to Business and Human Rights;
- Combatting environmental degradation and/or violence and discrimination against women;
- Resolving land rights issues;
- Advocating for better stakeholder engagement and public participations on National Action Plans on business and human rights;
- Advocating to eliminate the use of strategic litigation against public participation (SLAPP);
- Active in information exchange, capacity building and otherwise bringing visibility to Business and Human Rights issues;
- Working with Indigenous Peoples on abuses related to business operations
- Working to address needs and challenges of human rights defenders (HRD), including protection from spurious defamation laws by businesses
