1.	Can any firm use alternative technology for	No. The Firm needs to follow the tested

2.	In some cases, free source satellite image may not be sufficient for the work. In such cases, whether the Firm can use other satellite image?	Other satellite images of good quality can be used provided that it has copyright issues. If the Firm has satellite image that they bought previously, and the Firm has no legal restriction to use it for other purposes, then they can use it. Otherwise, the Frim needs to find several free source images and choose the best one.
3.	Will UNDP assist the selected Consulting Firm to collect the data and information from other government and non- government sources? Or, is it the responsibility of the Firm to collect the necessary information?	If the Firm needs any data and information from other sources, the Firm will have to collect it by their own.
4.	Will UNDP issue any letter to city authority for starting the Assignment in the particular city?	UNDP Project has already deployed staffs in many cities. Deploying staffs in other cities are in process. During starting of the poverty mapping activities of the Firm, if it happens that in some particular city there's no UNDP staff in the city, only in that case, UNDP will issue a letter to Mayor with introduction of the Firm selected for the Assignment and request to extend cooperation to complete the assignment.
5.	Can Firm propose alternate methodology?	The participatory poverty mapping methodology is tested, piloted and already carried out in several cities. The same methodology will have to be followed by the firm and there's no scope to change the core steps of the methodology.
