Your Proposal must be expressed in the **English or Ukrainian or Russian**, and valid for a minimum period of **90 days**.

In the course of preparing your Proposal, it shall remain your responsibility to ensure that it reaches the address above on or before the deadline. Proposals that are received by UNDP after the deadline indicated above, for whatever reason, shall not be considered for evaluation. If you are submitting your Proposal by email, kindly ensure that they are signed and in the .pdf format, and free from any virus or corrupted files.

NB. The Offeror shall create 2 archive files (*.zip format only!): one should include *technical proposal*, another one should include *financial proposal* and be encrypted with password. Both files should be attached to the email letter.

During evaluation process only technically compliant companies will be officially asked by UNDP procurement unit via email to provide password to archive with financial proposal. Please do not include the password either to email letter or technical proposal and disclose before official request.

Messages should **not exceed 8 MB in size**. Offers larger than 8 MB should be split into several messages and each message subject should indicate “part x of y” besides the marking mentioned in the announcement and the solicitation documents. Messages larger than 8 Mb may not be delivered. *All electronic submissions are confirmed by an automatic reply.*

The Offeror shall mark the email letter/s:

Services proposed shall be reviewed and evaluated based on completeness and compliance of the Proposal and responsiveness with the requirements of the RFP and all other annexes providing details of UNDP requirements.

The Proposal that meets all the evaluation criteria and offers the best value for money shall be selected and awarded the contract. Any offer that does not meet the requirements shall be rejected.

Any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price shall be re-computed by UNDP, and the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected. If the Service Provider does not accept the final price based on UNDP’s re-computation and correction of errors, its Proposal will be rejected.

No price variation due to escalation, inflation, fluctuation in exchange rates, or any other market factors shall be accepted by UNDP after it has received the Proposal. At the time of Award of Contract or Purchase Order, UNDP reserves the right to vary (increase or decrease) the quantity of services and/or goods, by up to a maximum twenty-five per cent (25%) of the total offer, without any change in the unit price or other terms and conditions.

**** Dear partners!**

The United Nations Office in Ukraine would like to inform you that the purchase of goods and services announced in the tender will be carried out within the project of international technical assistance.

According to the provisions of the Tax Code of Ukraine (paragraph 197.11), an exemption from VAT is provided for operations that are financed through material and technical assistance.

The procedure for obtaining the right to exemption from taxation for operations that are made within international technical assistance projects is regulated by the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine No.153 dated February 15, 2002.

According to this procedure, the price of the contract is determined "without VAT" and the tax invoice is drawn up in accordance with paragraph 2 of Order No. 1307. In the left part of this invoice, the corresponding mark "X" should be made and the type of reason 12 should be indicated. At the same time in the column "Recipient" (buyer) the name of the legal entity (UN Office in Ukraine) should be indicated, and in the column "Individual tax number of the beneficiary" (buyer) should be indicated conventional TIN (taxpayer reg. No.) "200000000000".

Based on the above stated, we request that you prepare your bid proposals / invoices for payment without VAT taking into account the provisions of the Ukrainian legislation stated in the above mentioned normative acts.

Представительство ООН в Украине информирует Вас, что приобретение товаров и услуг объявленных в тендере 056-2017-UNDP-UKR-RFQ-RPP производиться в рамках выполнения проекта международной технической помощи.

Согласно положений Налогового Кодекса Украины (п. 197.11) предусмотрено освобождение от налогообложения НДС операций, которые финансируются за счет материально-технической помощи.

Порядок получения права на освобождение от налогообложения операций, которые производятся в рамках проектов международной технической помощи регламентируется постановлением Кабинета Министров Украины от 15 февраля 2002 года №153.

В случае наличия права на применение этой НДСной льготы на дату получения аванса от ПРООН вы должны составить и зарегистрировать в ЕРНН налоговую накладную (далее — НН), которая заполняется следующим образом:

- в графе «Складена на операції, звільнені від оподаткування» верхней левой части делается пометка «Без ПДВ»;
- в раздел А табличной части НН (строки I - X) вносятся обобщающие данные по операциям, на которые складывается такая НН, а именно: в строке I указывается общая сумма средств, подлежащих уплате с учетом НДС; в строке IX — общий объем поставки товаров/услуг. Строки II - VIII раздела А не заполняются;
- в графе 2 раздела В указывается номенклатура услуг поставщика (продавца);
- в графа 3.3 раздела В — код услуги согласно ГКПУ. Графа 3.3 заполняются на всех этапах поставки услуг.
- в графе 4 и 5 — единица измерения услуг;
- в графе 6 — количество (объем) поставки услуг;
- в графе 7 — цена поставки единицы услуги без учета НДС;
- в графе 8 — указывается код ставки НДС 903;
- в графе 9 — код льготы согласно Справочнику других налоговых льгот налоговых льгот, утвержденному ГФС по состоянию на дату составления НН — «14060523».
- в графе 10 — объем поставки без учета НДС (сумма аванса). Детально — в материалах «Налоговая накладная – 2017: порядок заполнения» и «Новая налоговая накладная в образцах».

Что касается налогового кредита с НДС по покупкам материалов для выполнения соответствующих строительных работ, то здесь правила его компенсации, предусмотренные п. 198.5 НКУ, не действуют. Ведь согласно п. 198.5 НКУ на операции по поставке товаров и услуг, освобождение от налогообложения НДС которых предусмотрено п. 197.11 НКУ, правила начисления налоговых обязательств не распространяются.

Это значит, что в ходе использования материалов, которые покупались с НДС, для выполнения данных работ налоговый кредит компенсировать не нужно, соответственно не нужно и начислять для этого налоговые обязательства.

Исходя из вышесказанного, просим Вас формировать Ваши тендерные заявки/счета на оплату без НДС учитывая положения украинского законодательства, изложенного в перечисленных нормативных актах.

I. BACKGROUND

The ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine has had a direct and highly negative impact on social cohesion, resilience, livelihoods, community security, and the rule of law. Recognizing the need to urgently address reconstruction, economic recovery and peacebuilding needs in areas affected both directly and indirectly by the conflict, in late 2014 the Government of Ukraine requested technical assistance and financial support from the international community to assess priority recovery needs. In late 2014, the United Nations (UN), the World Bank (WB) and the European Union (EU) conducted a Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessment, which was endorsed by the Cabinet of Ministers in mid-2015.

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) has been active and present in eastern Ukraine for the past decade, prior to the conflict, with a focus on community development, civil society development, and environmental protection. Work on addressing the specific conflict-related development challenges discussed above built on this earlier engagement, established partnerships, and started in 2015 through the Recovery and Peacebuilding Programme (RPP). The RPP is a multi-donor funded framework programme led by the UNDP in collaboration with the Government of Ukraine and implemented in cooperation with a number of partnering UN agencies (UN Women, FAO, UNFPA).

The RPP was designed to respond to, and mitigate, the causes and effects of the conflict. It is based on findings of the Recovery and Peacebuilding Assessment (RPA) and is aligned to the State Target Programme for Recovery as well as to the two oblast development strategies up to 2020. It takes into account the opportunities that have arisen from the Minsk Protocol of September 2014 and the renewal of its cease-fire provisions (the latest cease-fire having been agreed in March 2018) and is also fully adjusted to the humanitarian-development nexus. It is an integral component of the UNDP Country Programme and is therefore fully aligned with the United Nations

Partnership Framework (UNPF). It is closely interlinked with the Democratic Governance and Reform Programme, operating nationally and in all of Ukraine's regions, and is consistent with the SDGs.

The Programme's interventions are grouped under the following key Programme components, which reflect the region's priority needs:

Component 1: Economic Recovery and Restoration of Critical Infrastructure

Component 2: Local Governance and Decentralization Reform

Component 3: Community Security and Social Cohesion.

The Programme, which operates on the basis of a pooled funding arrangement, follows a multi-sectoral programme-based approach and is implemented using an area-based methodology. It is a unifying interventions framework for 10 projects funded by 12 international partners and is worth about 63 million USD.

In October 2018, four UN agencies (UNDP, UN Women, FAO and the UNFPA) have countersigned a new joint project document, funded by the EU. The overall objective of the project is to restore effective governance and promote reconciliation in the crisis-affected communities of Donetsk and Luhansk regions of Ukraine, thereby enhancing the credibility and legitimacy of local governments in the government-controlled areas (GCAs) of the regions. It will contribute to peacebuilding and prevent further escalation of conflict in Ukraine through effective and accountable decentralization, gender-responsive recovery planning and equal access to services, as well as enhanced community security and social cohesion.

This endeavor will be achieved through the pursuit of the following specific objectives:

1. To enhance local capacity for gender-responsive decentralization and administrative reforms to improve governance, local development and the delivery of services.
2. To stimulate employment and economic growth by providing assistance to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) development through demand-driven business development services and professional skills training.
3. To enhance social cohesion and reconciliation through promotion of civic initiatives.
4. To support sector reforms and structural adjustments in health, education and critical public infrastructure to mitigate direct impacts of the conflict.

The need to provide new employment opportunities for people formerly employed in heavy industry, mining and ports in the conflict-affected region, including in agriculture, fishery and related businesses, is urgent. At the same time, the conflict has meant that bank lending, leasing, and other credits (including trade credit), has completely stopped in the region, and businesses are struggling to get access to finance and connect to markets in the rest of Ukraine and beyond. Inclusive economic growth needs to be advanced through support for micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) and trade development in the priority sectors of economy in the target regions. Such sectors have already been identified in most areas of Luhansk and Donetsk (GCAs) oblasts.

To continue this process and target the planned interventions, UN RPP is seeking a legal entity that will identify and prioritize functional non-agricultural, agricultural and food-processing value chains in the government-controlled areas along the coast line of the sea of Azov including Zaporizhia oblast.

II. MAIN OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The overall objective of the value chain (hereinafter – VC) mapping is to identify functional non-agricultural, agricultural and food-processing value chains in Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk oblasts along the coast line of the sea of Azov, analyse them and prioritize for the further analysis and targeted support in their development.

The mapping is to be market-oriented and shall start from the assessment of target region's market structure and identify the market opportunities for specific agricultural and non-agricultural products and processed food, and then move backwards the supply chains to assess their key elements and gaps. Mapping of the VCs shall take into account territorial specificity and the size of producers and manufacturers. Mapping shall also envisage identifying opportunities for MSME cooperation essential for sustainable and successful VCs as well as assessment of resources availability and specific VCs needs.

III. SCOPE OF WORK AND EXPECTED OUTPUTS

The Contractor will conduct overall mapping of non-agricultural, agricultural and food-processing value chains in the areas along the coast line of the sea of Azov in Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk oblasts and prioritize them in terms of growth potential and impact on livelihood of the two regions to target further UN RPP interventions.

1. VCs mapping:

- Develop a detailed work plan, mapping approach, assessment methodology, elaborate criteria for VCs prioritization;
- Using various sources of information (official data, valid studies and reviews, etc.) carry out a multi-year and prospect analysis of dynamic supply and demand balances for key non-agricultural and agricultural products, processed food products in the two target oblasts, inbound and outbound logistics structure, production units' capacity, study the market structure (domestic and external), review international markets and needs for trade facilitation. Such assessment shall be territorially specific, based on critical areas of economy, production assets, technological and technical gaps, processing capacity, emerging/potential market needs, consumption structure, access to market, administrative and business support services, existing clusters and cooperatives, and related regulations, trade and production policies. Based on the findings create the commodity balance sheets by oblasts, identify the key VCs in both targeted regions and create their generalized profiles.

Output 1:

- Detailed work plan developed and approved by UN RPP;
- The VCs in the areas along the coast line of Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk oblasts identified;
- Detailed profiles of the key VCs operating in the areas along the Azov sea coast line of Zaporizhzhia and Donetsk oblasts created, including the commodity balance sheets by oblast;
- An Inception Report developed and approved by UN RPP explaining the mapping approach, methodology, containing elaborated criteria for VCs prioritization and a list of key sources of information that shall be used for the purpose of the assignment.

Estimated implementation period: up to 30 calendar days after the Contract start date

2. VCs prioritization and analysis:

- Based on the previously approved criteria for VC prioritization that should include, but not be limited to, influence on the target hromada's economy, potential for growth, sustainability, human capital, food security, women/youth employment, etc., score and prioritize the identified VCs;
- Carry out an in-depth analysis of the priority VCs, assess their competitiveness, identify the constraints for their growth, added-value and income generating opportunities, untapped economic development opportunities that can support the chains, determine how to create advantages for the targeted sectors in the context of local and regional trends. Feasible opportunities for internal and external economic cooperation as well as the ways for newly-created enterprises to establish partnerships with the already existing entities shall be identified for each specific VC;

- Based on the findings of in-depth analysis create detailed profiles of the prioritized VCs including a development scenario analysis.

Output 2:

- VCs screened against the pre-defined criteria and prioritized;
- In-depth analysis of the prioritized value chains conducted;
- The detailed profiles of the key VCs in the area along the coastline of the Azov sea created, including a development scenario analysis;
- Interim report submitted and approved by UN RPP.

Estimated implementation period: up to 60 calendar days after the Contract start date

3. Action plan development and reporting:

- Prepare a detailed action plan to address the urgent needs of both MSMEs and buyers in each of the priority VCs. Recommend appropriate interventions and facilitation guidelines. The action plan should address among other things the following:
 - technology/product development
 - market access and trade promotion (market information)
 - input supply (including unskilled and skilled labor and training needs)
 - management and organization of the entities involved
 - regulatory/policy
 - finance
 - infrastructure.

The plan should consider the potential of certain chains to promote the inclusion of women and vulnerable groups.

- Prepare and deliver presentation and handouts of the mapping exercise results;
- Prepare, submit and get approval by the direct supervisor a comprehensive final report (*single spacing, Noto Sans or Arial font, size 11, Ukrainian and English language*) on results of the assignment that includes, but is not limited to the following components:
 - Introduction
 - Study context, background, scope and objectives
 - Mapping approach and methodology
 - Data analysis and key findings and conclusions
 - Recommendations for further actions and lessons learnt
 - Key data sources.
- Prepare Executive Summary of the mapping and analysis conducted (*Ukrainian and English language*) indicating the main findings and development recommendations;
- Prepare Power Point Presentation (*about 15 slides, Ukrainian and English language*) that includes:
 - Background information;
 - Study purpose and objectives;
 - Detailed overview of the prioritised VCs;
 - Key findings and conclusions;
 - Generalized development recommendations.

Output 3:

- A detailed action plan to address the urgent needs of both MSMEs and buyers in each of the priority VCs developed. Appropriate interventions and facilitation guidelines provided;
- A comprehensive final report on results of the VCs mapping and analysis submitted and approved by UN RPP;
- Executive summary created and accepted by UN RPP;
- Presentation on study results developed and accepted by UN RPP.

Estimated implementation period: up to 90 calendar days after the Contract start date
