After presentation of the key components of ITB and in-depth highlights of the Tender document, the forum was opened for questions and answers as shown below:

1. As per section 4.2 of the tender document i.e. the evaluation critea part e states that the company must have the total average annual turnover of USD 300,000 which is very high for cleaning companies in Tanzania

Answer: Understood. Most of Tanzania cleaning companies do not have that capabilities hence the required average turnover for 3 years will be reduced to USD 150,000.

<u>Thus, Section 4.2 of Tender document, Part 1 – Preliminary examination criteria, sub section e – financial soundness will be adjusted as below:</u>

Bidders shall provide documentary evidence in the form of latest independently audited financial accounts for the last three years in English proving that the total average annual turnover over each of the last three years exceeded the amount of USD 150,000
