1	What is the engine emission standard requirement for Koror, Palau?	-	Internationally recognized standard, preferably US standard
2	Are there any special certificates required for these vehicles?	-	As outlined in the Section 4. Evaluation Criteria of the tender document, Bidders are required to provide export/import licenses (if applicable), patent registration certificates if technologies submitted in the bid is patented by the Bidder, quality certificates, certificates of origin, environmental compliance certificates, other special certificates that might be applicable for the goods to be offered by your company
3	What is the driving type: LHD (left-hand drive) or RHD (right-hand drive)?	-	US standard
4	First of all, we are registered at the eTendergin platform as it is indicated in the ITB but we are not able to find this bid. Check out the picture below. Can you please tell us how to find this tender? Can you give us the "Event ID"?	-	Please follow instructions on bids submission Section 3. Bid Data Sheet and submit your bid in .pdf format to the email etenderbox.pacific@undp.org on or before the bids submission deadline. No need for submission through eTendering tool this time.
5	Do we have to supply with our offer the documents related in the "Section 4. Evaluation Criteria" (Forms A to G)?	-	Please make sure that your bid includes eligibility documents requested in Section 4. Evaluation Criteria
6	Are the "Prepare Bid Response – Answer Bid Factors" technical or administrative questions?	-	Please use returnable forms provided in the solicitation document while preparing your bids. Since eTendering tool has not been used for this tender, there are no bid factor questions.
7	Emission level of the engine?	-	emission level of the engine should comply with the latest international standards
8	Can we only offer the rescue pumper tanker or do we have to offer both as a mandatory?	-	Bidders can bid either for both lots or for one lot. Evaluation of bids and contract award will be lot based. However, bidders are required to offer two options for each lot, i.e. delivery under DAP and FOB.
