#### **B. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The main purpose of Recycling Pilot Project is to develop a case for integrating recycling in solid waste management systems by promoting the 4Rs (Refuse, Reduce, Recycle, and Recover) waste management principles. Community engagement is integral to the project in order to promote segregation of recyclable waste at source (household) and in the community, to promote environmentally responsible waste management, and to create a favorable enabling environment for creating a sustainable waste recycling enterprise. This pilot project aims to achieve the following outputs:

- Output 1: Community members increased awareness of recycling and change in behavior on managing household solid waste.
- Output 2: Improved capacity of recycling businesses enterprise to operate a sustainable operation.
- Output 3: Improved coordination and networking of private enterprise, GoTL and other stakeholder to create an environment promote private participation in responsible and sustainable waste management.

#### C. SCOPE OF WORK

Monitoring and Reporting Officer will work under direct supervision of the Programme Manager and Project Coordinator and in close coordination with Recycling Promotion Pilot project team and Knua Juventude Fila Liman, to provide technical and advisory support for the implementation and monitoring of the recycling promotion pilot project, particularly assessing the capacity/sustainability of existing community-led recycling business, environmental impact assessment to business idea, and the area of socialization awareness behavior change campaign as well as research and analysis to support development of a scaling-up concept.



### Specific responsibility will include:

- Conduct environmental Impact Assessment of both existing and new community-lead recycling initiative
- Asses project progress and impact, and draft monthly, quarterly, and annual progress report on Recycling Promotion Pilot Project
- Conduct interview with the beneficiaries of recycling business and write article or stories
  on how this project benefits the community.
- Support Social Innovation Challenge YOUTH Co:Lab, focusing on sustainable waste management circular economy including reviewing applications
- Support <u>awareness-raising and behavioral change</u> to integrate zero plastic policy, 4R approach, and Green Suku model as well as SEA's Green School model including the result of the recent result baseline survey at suku Caicoli
- Support training to youth volunteers and students, and communities in Motael, Caicoli, to raise their awareness on (waste management decree-law, zero plastic waste policy, and sustainable waste management (4Rs), and green suku concept at Suku Caicoli (5 aldeias in Motael, 5 aldeis in Caicoli, and in schools in both Caicoli and Motael) on the concept of Green Suku and Green School in partnership with individuals (Brigada Suku Matak) and youth groups. This includes preparing the pre and post-test showing participant's awareness before and after the training. The training should be interactive and practical including hands-on training on recycling.
- Support establishment of an Integrated Waste Management Facility (IWMF) at <u>suku</u>
   <u>Motael</u>; and train to youth volunteers on the role of the IWMF including the various activities and work flows.
- Support the document translation from English to Tetun, and vice-versa
- Organize regular Recycling training and Expo at the IWMF to showcase the various products (recycling, compost, biodegradable).

#### E. INSTITUTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

The selected consultant will work under Project Coordinator for Recycling Promotion Pilot Project and UNDP Programme Manager for Sustainable Development.
