I. BACKGROUND

In 1993, the Government of Jamaica acceded to the Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer and its Montreal Protocol on Substances that deplete the Ozone Layer and has ratified all the previous Amendments to the Montreal Protocol. The country is currently taking significant steps towards the ratification of the Kigali Amendment to the Montreal Protocol on substances that deplete the ozone layer, 2016 (Kigali Amendment), which is a significant stride in the fight against climate change.

The Government of Jamaica has a well-established Legal and Institutional Framework to implement the Montreal Protocol commitments. Notwithstanding, the new Kigali Amendment will bring additional challenges to determine: (a) the national requirements and needs for the ratification of this Amendment, (b) the establishment of a sound foundation to undertake future work towards its implementation and (c) help to bolster the efforts of the Government of Jamaica in the fight against global warming.

To this end, the services of a Content Writer is required to prepare public awareness material to sensitize the key stakeholders of the Kigali Amendment and the Montreal Protocol.

II. SCOPE OF WORK, ACTIVITIES, AND DELIVERABLES

Scope of Work

A key mandate of the project is to promote the Kigali Amendment among the key stakeholders. A Content Writer is being engaged to produce a pocketbook. Information from this pocketbook should also be used to develop a five minute video feature, develop a brochure and a fact sheet. Additionally, the Content Writer will also need to develop a process flow chart documenting the steps to apply for an import permit.

Specifically, the consultant will:

- Develop a pocketbook which provides information on the Montreal Protocol and the Kigali
 Amendment. The pocketbook should be written in clear concise language that is easy to
 understand using infographics, tables and charts where necessary. The pocketbook should
 provide information which answers the following questions:
 - o What is the Montreal Protocol?
 - o What is the Kigali Amendment?
 - O How will the Kigali Amendment affect Jamaica's:
 - 1. Refrigeration and Air Conditioning (RAC) sector
 - 2. Importers of Hydro-chlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) and Hydro-chlorocarbons (HFCs)
 - 3. Other relevant stakeholders
 - O What is required for Jamaica to ratify the Kigali Amendment?
 - o What are the next steps after Jamaica ratifies the Kigali Amendment?
- The booklet should also contain an info-graphic which outlines important Kigali Amendment timelines including specific dates for adoption, ratification etc.
- Using the information in the pocketbook, write a television script which will be used to develop a five (5) minute video feature that will use both stock footage and motion graphics. The script should include information on the Montreal Protocol and the Kigali Amendment. The target audience for the video will be Refrigeration and Air Condition (RAC) Technicians and importers of Hydro-chlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs) and Hydro-chlorocarbons (HFCs). The script should be written in clear concise language that is easy to understand, indicating areas that should be graphically represented.
- Using the information from the pocketbook, develop the following communication products:
 - Brochure which provides an overview of the Kigali Amendment and the Montreal Protocol
 - o Fact sheet outlining the role of the key agencies in the Kigali Amendment and
 - o A flow chart which demonstrates the steps to apply for an import permit

All deliverables should be developed in consultation with key stakeholders including but not limited to the Environment and Risk Management Branch of the Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation, the National Ozone Officer in the National Environment and Planning Agency, the Standards and Regulatory Branch of the Ministry of Health and the Jamaica Customs Agency. A graphic designer and

a Motion Graphics Designer will be engaged to do layout and graphic design for the aforementioned items. The Content Writer will be expected to work closely with both designers.
