If the supplier does not accept the final price based on UNDP's re-computation and correction of errors, its quotation will be rejected.

After UNDP, has identified the lowest price offer, UNDP reserves the right to award the contract based only on the prices of the goods in the event that the transportation cost (freight and insurance) is found to be higher than UNDP's own estimated cost if sourced from its own freight forwarder and insurance provider.

At any time during the validity of the quotation, no price variation due to escalation, inflation, fluctuation in exchange rates, or any other market factors shall be accepted by UNDP after it has received the quotation. SCOPE OF WORK

Rehabilitation Athrban primary mixed school in Hawija-Kirkuk Gov.

1. PROJECT BACKGROUND

a. Project description

The objective of the rehabilitation Athrban primary mixed school is to restore primary education to the in Athrban village, Hawija. The building is owned and operated by Dept. of Education, Kirkuk Governorate

b. Direct and indirect beneficiaries

- i. Direct beneficiaries: 9 teachers employed and 392 students.
- ii. Indirect beneficiaries: population of around 810 people (40% male and 60% female).
- c. Impact and how it will be measured (quantitative measures)
 Restoration of basic education to the children students of Athrban Village and prepare them for further education.

2. LOCATION

The project is in Athrban Village, Hawija District, Kirkuk Governorate. Coordinates: 35.105685, 43.598451

3. BUILDING/CONSTRUCTION DESCRIPTION

The Athrban primary mixed school in Hawija is a one-story construction, with 6 class rooms, bathrooms, management offices and store on the ground floor.

4. DESCRIPTION OF THE DAMAGE

The damage to this school is by impact points from small arms fire resulting in 10% damage to the school. Several the doors have been damaged, sanitation units and pipes are blocked by solid wastes, so would also expect the water supply network and sewerage net also to be damaged. Electrical items have been looted or damaged, so all will need replacing from boards, cables, fans to lighting.

5. WORKS ON BRIEF

The rehabilitation work includes civil, sanitary and electrical works.

- a. The civil part of the works includes <u>but not limited to</u> site preparation, concrete works, gypsum plastering, painting, steel doors, crystal clear glass, repair steel windows, and suspended ceiling as indicated on the BoQ.
- b. The sanitary works includes <u>but not limited to</u> water tank installation, ceramic lavatory pedestal, siphon, mixer taps, drain pipes, refurbishment of sewerage pipes and water pump as indicated on the BoQ.
- c. The electrical works includes <u>but not limited to</u> provision and installation of main distribution board, sub distribution boards, circuit and power cable, ceiling fan, fluorescent fixture, switches, brackets, outdoor lighting, split unit air-conditioning (2 ton) and electrical water boiler as indicated on the BoO.

6. DURATION OF THE PROJECT
