##### **Project Background:**

Currently under GFATM grant / Round 9, UNDP is focusing its efforts into increasing TB Case Detection Rate (CDR) in KR-I to empower it to reach the National CDR rate by improving the health-care TB related services provided to the population. Enabling effective and sustained access to TB care by expanding health-care TB related services in KR-I is required to improve diagnostic capacity taking into consideration a worsening crisis in the last few months that has been faced by Iraq which led to large-scale population movement with an estimated 1.8 million IDPs across Iraq with the increasing number of Syrian refugees.
