

## **Clarifications 1**

### **RFP150320-01**

Q. Can a Consultant have his/her name on two separate bids?

A. Yes

Q. What is the IPCC methodology to be used: is it the UNFCCC 2007 IPPC methodology for Non-Annex 1 Parties, and if so will this be provided upfront to the Consultants since it is only available to country focal points;

A. Yes, it will be provided by Government

Q. Will the SNC have to be accompanied by the First BUR (Biennial Update Report)?

A. Yes

Q. Will the GHG Inventory for 2000 have to be redone if using a methodology other than that of the INC, namely the IPCC (1996) Revised methodology, so as to maintain consistency and comparability of the time series?

A. It may have to be redone, based on discussions with Government Focal Point

Q. To what extent is the Consultant required to undertake capacity building in climate models: this requires specialized pre-requisite knowledge (math, statistics and physics) and powerful computers.

A. To be defined in the proposal in compliance with what is expected to be in the SNC

Q. Please clarify: 'Production of suitable non-existent climate change education material and website' (pg. 12)

A. Knowledge products and public awareness material

Q. Kindly clarify the meaning of SAP – page 21 of the TOR (it is not in the list of acronyms).

A. Reference is to the Second National Communications Report

Q. Please clarify if the group of experts should elaborate a new inventory for the years 2002,2004, 2006, and 2008 or just revise them.

A. The revision or elaboration of a new GHG inventories is up to the firm to decide what is the best way forward and may be elaborated further *with* discussions with Government and UNDP

Q. Regarding additional support from the Government of Grenada which will include, among others, the support for all arrangements for meetings and workshops, would it include for example the list of participants, venue and equipment?

A. Yes

Q. In addition, for the Technical Proposal (Appendix 3), is there a format for the preparation of D or E?

A. No
