

## PROCUREMENT NOTICE – INDIVIDUAL CONSULSTANT (S) MANAGING THE HUMAN-WILDLIFE INTERFACE TO SUSTAIN THE FLOW OF AGRO-ECOSYSTEM SERVICES AND PREVENT ILLEGAL WILDLIFE TRAFFICKING IN THE KGALAGADI AND GHANZI DRYLANDS

The Ministry of Environment, Wildlife and Tourism, is in the process of preparing a Global Environment Facility (GEF) funding request for Full Sized Project entitled *Managing the human-wildlife interface to sustain the flow of agro-ecosystem services and prevent illegal wildlife trafficking in the Kgalagadi and Ghanzi Drylands*, with support from UNDP. In light of this, UNDP wishes to invite qualified individual consultants with local expertise in the natural resource management areas mentioned below, to form part of a team to develop the funding proposal for submission to the GEF.

The team will conduct baseline studies and stakeholder consultations in the project area (Kgalagadi and Ghanzi Districts). The consultants sought are as follows:

- Land-Use Planning and NRM Specialist (to also act as Lead National Consultant);
- 2. Wildlife Management Specialist;
- 3. Range Management Specialist;
- 4. Sustainable Livelihoods and NRM Specialist.
