- 1 Q. The TOR mentions the site selection should be based on the vulnerability criteria of UNDP, can I have a reference to assist us in knowing better what would be the regions that meet these criteria?
 - A. Please find below the list of vulnerable communities in North Area of UNDP for reference. However, please note that the specific site selection should first be carried out after the implementing agent has been identified, as this should be identified in cooperation with UNDP and MoA, based on both the vulnerable communities targeted by UNDP as well as the areas priorities by MoA under the 40 million forest trees program.
