Summary of proposal:

UN Women envisages entering into long-term agreement (LTA) with the successful Proposer(s) for the provision of an indefinite quantity of the specified services in support of UN Women operations. In the event of UN Women signing long term agreements, the following shall apply:

- a) The agreements shall be valid for 2 years from the date where both parties have signed the LTA with an option for a further extension of 24 months at UN Women's discretion. The successful proposer(s) shall have the right to review their prices every 24 months from commencement of the LTA, and shall notify UN Women in writing 90 days prior to the 24-month period of a proposed price decrease or increase. The successful proposer(s) shall provide proper justification for any price increase. UN Women shall be entitled to either accept the price decrease / increase or to cancel the LTA, and shall notify the successful proposer(s) in writing of its decision.
- b) UN Women will not be committed to purchase any minimum quantity of the Services, and purchases will be made only if and when there is an actual requirement. UN Women shall not be liable for any cost in the event that no purchases are made under any resulting LTA.
- c) UN Women intends to award more than one LTA to the responsive Proposers. During the validity of the LTAs, the LTA holders will be invited to quote for each specific requirement based on secondary bidding in order to ensure best value for money through effective competition based on those specific requirements.
- d) The Secondary bidding requirement will be waived for jobs leading to Purchase Orders below USD 5,000.
- e) The LTA holders must be able to provide quality and on-time services.
- f) The confirmation of orders for specific requirements will be placed by issuing Purchase Orders. The UN Women General Conditions of LTA will be in force.

- brief presentation of your enterprise including number of staff, turnover, years in business, business registration documents,
- Description of the qualifications, areas of expertise of the company roster,
- Interested Companies must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochure, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc...). Companies may associate to enhance their qualifications.
- Companies will be selected in accordance with the procedure set out in the UN-Women Procurement Guidelines and UN-Women Financial Rules and Regulations.
- EOI from suppliers failing to provide the request information will be disregarded. Invitations to bid and any subsequent purchase order will be issued in accordance with the rule and procedures of UN-Women.
- This EOI does not entail any commitment on the part of UN-Women, either financial or otherwise. UN-Women reserve the right to accept or reject any or all EOI without incurring any obligation to inform the affected applicant/s of the grounds.
