B. CLARIFICATIONS

1	QUESTION:	Could you please explain the difference between tenders
1		ITB/GFATM05-2016 and ITB/GFATM14-2016?

	UNDP:	The quality standards sought of the medicines and health commodities under ITB GFATM/05-2016 necessitated that the medicines and health commodities must have approval of a Stringent Drug Regulatory Authority (SRA) as defined by WHO. Please note this quality criterion applies in the case as well as of ITB GFATM/14-2016 launched on 18 July.
		In light of several offers not passing this threshold, 29 items have been cancelled from the first round and a second round ITB GFATM/14-2016 launched. Concerning ITB-GFATM/05-2016, notice of cancellation for 29 items is posted at: <u>http://procurement-notices.undp.org/view_awards.cfm</u> . The results of the balance items pursuant to GFATM/05-2016 will be announced shortly.
		A Stringent Regulatory Authority (SRA) as defined by WHO is a regulatory authority which is: (a) a member of the International Conference on Harmonisation of Technical Requirements for Registration of Pharmaceuticals for Human Use (ICH) (as specified on <u>www.ich.org</u>); or (b) an ICH observer, being the European Free Trade Association (EFTA), as represented by Swissmedic and Health Canada (as may be updated from time to time); or (c) a regulatory authority associated with an ICH member through a legally-binding, mutual recognition agreement including Australia, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway (as may be updated from time to time). ICH members include:
		the EU Member States, Japan, the US.
	QUESTION:	We supply Clopidogrel besylate 75mg, film-coated tablets. Would you consider besylate an acceptable alternative to hydrogen sulfate, which is listed in the solicitation document?
2	UNDP:	The specification sought for Clopidogrel 75mg is in fact hydrogen sulfate. Whilst we will accept bids for alternate packaging presentations, we are unable to accept bids for alternate specifications, such as Clopidogrel 75mg besylate.
2		Please refer to DS. No. 6 of the ITB - a Bidder may submit an alternative Bid for packaging presentations (e.g., blister pack vs. bottles, tablets vs. capsules) <u>only</u> . Alternative Bids must meet the base case (i.e., compliance with the product specifications requested by UNDP in this ITB). UNDP shall only consider the alternative Bids offered by the Bidder whose Bid for the base case was determined to be the Bid with the highest evaluated score.

	UNDP:	ITB GFATM/14-2016 is an open invitation to entities for the supplies of medicines to Sudan. As the solicitation documents state the conditions for eligibility, we draw your attention to the following points:
4		 In the context of this ITB, UNDP will only procure medicines that have been approved by a Stringent Drug Regulatory Authority (SRA) as defined by WHO. It is not compulsory that one has an agent or local representative in Sudan for purposes to partake in the tender.
		 Effective registration with the National Medicines and Poisons Board, Sudan is not an exclusionary requirement to participate in the tender; however bidders will be encouraged to obtain registration with the NMPB to ensure continuity of supply over the term of the LTA.
	QUESTION:	Our company maintains a WHO-GMP compliant manufacturing facility and our products are registered in a number of countries, which justify the quality standards of our products; however not in a SRA country. Are we eligible to participate in this tender?
5	UNDP:	Should your company maintain the requisite quality threshold specific for this Sudan tender, you are eligible to participate and submit all documentation an offer in response to ITB GFATM/14-2016. Pharmaceuticals, otherwise without the approval of a SRA as defined by WHO will not be compliant with the quality threshold.
