Phase 1: Installation of new fiber cabling:

1. Please confirm if Phase 1 can be completed during UNDP's normal working hours.

A: Confirmed

2. Will UNDP be providing the Patch Cables?

A: Yes

Phase 2: Relocate existing cabling:

3. Please confirm if Phase 2 shall only be done during weekends.

A: Yes, Phase 2 must be done during weekend hours. Please note that UNDP has a holiday on Monday September 5th (Labor Day) as well Monday September 12th. Vendors have the option to work on those holidays if they wish as they will not be working hours for UNDP.

4. In the RFQ, Phase 2 consists of “Relocate existing 50 pairs of FDDI grade MMF cable along with patch panels from the cabinet R2P5 to the cabinet R9P6”. Does “Pairs” refer to strands? For example, does “50 Pairs” refer to 100 strands?

A: Yes, this is correct.

5. Please confirm that the testing of fiber cables shall be done in a different building.

A: Confirmed. UNDP can coordinate this with other UN offices stationed in other buildings.

Other General questions:

6. How will the Contractor have access to the building when conducting the services?

A: A UNDP representative will provide access and accompany the personnel during the service periods.

7. Is the Loading dock open and accessible on weekends?

A: This can be arranged by UNDP in coordination with the Building Management, as necessary.

8. Is the FF-building a Union building?

A: Yes, it is a Union building.
