CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR CLIMATE CHANGE PILOT PROJECTS

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in collaboration with the Ministry of Economic Planning, Sustainable Development, Industry, Information and Labour, is pleased to announce its call for Project Proposals under the Japan-Caribbean Climate Change Partnership Project (J-CCCP).

The J-CCCP aims to support countries in advancing the process of inclusive low-emission risk-resilient development by improving energy security and integrating medium to long-term planning for adaptation to climate change within, or aligned with, improved development planning and budgeting processes. Outcome two (2) of the project seeks to adopt and implement mitigation and adaptation technologies through the execution of pilot projects under four (4) focal areas and six (6) priority areas, in the table below.

Focal Areas	Priority Areas
Water Resources Management	Output 2.1: Affordable climate-resilient community-based water harvesting, storage and distribution systems designed, built and rehabilitated in selected target areas
Sustainable Agriculture	Output 2.2: Crop diversification practices tested for their ability to improve resilience of farmers to climate change impacts
	Output 2.3: Community-based water capacity and irrigation systems improved or developed to test their ability to raise agricultural productivity
	Output 2.4: Sustainable Agriculture (Climate-resilient agro-pastoral practices and technologies (e.g. water management and soil fertility) demonstrated in selected target areas.
Community-based Climate-smart Resilient Infrastructure	Output 2.5: Climate resilience and disaster risk management activities- Small-scale infrastructure implemented to reduce climate change and disaster-induced losses
Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency	Output 2.6: Climate resilience and disaster risk management activities (Energy pilot demonstrations applied to selected adaptation, mitigation and disaster risk management interventions to catalyse low-emission climate-resilient technology transfer, development and investments in the Caribbean)

The maximum grant amount per project is USD \$50,000 for a duration of up to 16 months upon approval of the project proposal. Eligibility

- The proposals must be submitted by a legally registered Non- Governmental Organization or Community Based Organization
- Pilot project proposals must demonstrate the integration of mitigation and adaptation technologies that will contribute to low emission and climate resilient communities and reduce community vulnerability
