1	<p><b>Location of Work:</b></p> <p>On page 3 of the attached RFP, it is mentioned: "Home Based, and Phnom Penh, Cambodia.</p> <p>On page 23, it is mentioned "The duty station of this assignment is a combination of home-based, Siem Reap and Phnom Penh." Could you please clarify?</p>	<p>Please follow page 23. The assignment will require the service provider to travel to Phnom Penh and Cambodia.</p>
2	<p><b>Duration of work</b> (linked to point 1.)-<i>comment.</i></p> <p>2 missions of four days are mentioned between November and January 2018. Activities 1 and 2 defined on page 22 are including technical and institutional arrangements, as well as waste composition and generation studies.</p> <p>Based on similarly conducted work, we would like to comment on the very limited time suggested.</p> <p>To conduct the study on composition and quantities, we consider seasonal variability of high interest to effectively assess the quality of the food waste, and thus would think that more time should be dedicated on site for both team leaders and Solid waste management experts. Observation is a key component to define the potential.</p>	<p>Two missions. 4 days will be allotted for each mission. There is a local waste operator collecting waste for this market and they can supply information related to waste composition and quantities.</p>
