UNDP Syria Procurement Unit has received questions regarding the subject Tendering Procedure. All questions received to-date are documented below with respective answers.

Questions and Answers-1-

- 1- Is there a camp or guesthouse to stay overnight in or near the power station?
The expert will be able to stay in a hotel in the Hotel in Tartous city (30 minutes far from the power plant).
- 2- If not, where is the next possibility to stay over night and which transportation is required and available?
UNDP will arrange his transportation from the hotel to the power plant in an armed vehicle.
- 3- Is there a canteen in the power station providing daily food? no, but many restaurants near the hotel?
No canteen in the power plant but many restaurants are available near the hotel.
- 4- How is the expert protected in view of the hostile situation?
UNDP will be responsible for the security of the expert.
- 5- Which is the best possibility to travel to the station? By car? By plane, if available?
UNDP will arrange the transportation to the power plant by an armed vehicle.



- 6- What is the difference between "Travel expenses to Join Duty Station <<>> and Duty travel?
To Join Duty Station=To join UNDP office

Duty travel = Travel to other locations

- 7- What is your term "Terminal Expenses"?
- Terminal expenses include all expenditures for transportation between the air terminal or other point of arrival or departure, and the hotel or place of dwelling, including transfer of baggage, and other incidental expenses. It should be paid as part of the travel advance or the travel claim settlement. No receipts are required for standard terminal expenses.
