We understand that a single proposal including both Micro assessment and Spot checks needs to be submitted in response to the RFP.<br/>Keeping in view the award criteria, shall the proposal be evaluated as a whole or it shall be evaluated lot wise i.e for micro-assessment separately and for spot checks separately?</p> <p>b. Is it permitted to submit proposal for one lot i.e for Micro- assessment only or for spot check only? If answer to this question is yes, can supplier submit two proposals for both services?</p> | <p>a. The proposal will be evaluated technically as a whole and financially the proposal for Spot Check and Micro assessment will be evaluated separately. Therefore, in the financial proposal, the offer for Spot Check and micro assessment should be clearly separate,</p> <p>b. It is permitted to submit for one lot only or both lots together by one bidder. Bidder cannot separate the lots Micro and Spot Checks if they submitting for both.</p> |
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
