Can you provide any further information on the rationale for this choice.	The "Feminist Participatory Action Research" methodology was chosen and agreed with the Ministry of Women's Affairs. FPAR is to be used with research participants from the 5 populations on a broadly basis to facilitate collective consciousness among them and ensure and that research participants gain access to and build critical knowledge/information that is able to influence the policy work of the Cambodian Government (to make gender policies more responsive to the specific needs of these women's populations). Applicants are encouraged to explain further in their proposals about their specific approaches to undertake the assignment as proposed in TOR.
