Dear Otar,

Thank you for your interest in the UNDP tender "Development of Performance Management System for Street cleaning and Waste Management Services in 23 Municipalities of Georgia".

Here is our response to your question:

Q1: PwC is network of member firms and each member firm is a separate legal entity. PwC Georgia intends to participate in above mentioned bid together with PwC Slovakia and PwC Poland. Does this imply that all three PwC entities should form Joint Venture/Consortium and present notarized Agreement? If this is a case, should we define Lead applicant as per Form C and should this Lead applicant solely meet Experience requirement.

A: Yes, since the member firms are separate legal entities, they need to form Joint Venture/Consortium/Association to submit a joint proposal. In this case, they need to provide a notarized agreement. Companies should also make sure, that both in an agreement and Form C, they nominate lead entity and provide proportion of responsibilities (in %) and type of services to be performed by each member of the JV/Consortium/Association.

As noted in the RFP (Section 4), the lead applicant should meet the requirement of minimum 5 years of demonstrated relevant experience.

Please be informed that, as per RFP, direct communication with prospective Proposers by e-mail is published as supplemental information.
