№	Question	Answer
1.	What is the budget available for this assignment? Is it possible to disclose this amount?	The amount planned for the procurement activity cannot be publicly announced in order not to affect the application process. Please provide your best offer, technically and financially.
2.	A list of corporate clients is required to support experience of the bidder. Is it possible to provide some other information, considering that the company signed NDAs with the clients?	We highly recommend contacting your clients with appropriate request to allow reflecting some limited information in the bidding documents, including reference letters and reports from previous clients concerning the service of the same nature. There is no other way to prove the expertise in the field, in addition to the profile of the company.
3.	What aspects of the project should be evaluated / assessed: financial, political etc.?	The evaluation should be based on the UN Evaluation Group's Norms and Standards for Evaluation and cover the following criteria: relevance, effectiveness, efficiency, sustainability and impact. Additionally, the evaluation should include a cost-efficiency assessment of the procured medicine and medical products for at least 5 nosologies (TBD). Please see the TOR for more information.
4.	What is the profile of the ideally fitting bidder? What is the field of the specialization needed?	The bidder should ideally have experience both in programme/project evaluation, and cost-efficiency assessment/economic analysis. We look for proved experience in health, governance, procurement analysis, finance and similar. Please see the TOR for more information.
5.	Technical evaluation criteria, Form 1, p. 1.3. to be read as follows:	At least <b>six</b> years of international or national experience of carrying out project/programme evaluations, economic and cost-benefit assessments and similar (6 -7 years of experience 50 pts, 8-10 years – 70 pts, more than 11 years – 90 pts)
