## Rehabilitation of Quran Vocational Center Qurna City – Basra Governorate – Iraq

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The project's aim is to rehabilitate Qurna Vocational traning center (VTC), The number of direct beneficiaries from this project is more than 350 of the people in the city.



The proposed services focus on the Rehabilitation three classroom of this building which welcomes 30-40 Beneficiaries from Former Fighter's Grant Project

The building is used for the following purposes: training , education and development the student skills in several fields ,welding , Automotive Mechanics, Electronics, Electricity, Air conditioning and refrigeration .

The project includes rehabilitation the following parts:

#### A- Classroom

#### 1- Electrical works for the main building

The work includes; supplying and installing LED spot lights, LED bulb lamps, outdoor lights, LED projectors, electrical wiring with ceiling fans and air ventilation fans, plug switches of 13, 14 and 32Amp, **2-** Mechanical works for the main building

The work includes; supplying, installing and connecting air-conditioning split unit for three classroom .

#### 3- Sanitary Works

Supply and installation of water filter (RO unit) connected with the water cooler, the price include all connection to water network pipe from the water tank and all work required and as directed by supervisor engineer.

#### 1- Sanitary works for the main building

The work includes; supplying and installing water heaters of 80 and 120 Lit capacity, supplying and installing water tanks, maintaining the existing sewage network, supplying and installing ceramic washbasins, a eastern toilets, taps, stainless steel double bowl sink, PPR pipes work, water pumps and rainwater pipes.
