| <b>Question 1.</b> | <b>The RFP is to build an asset management system for 8-month period. Can we propose an already build Asset Management System (Market leader according to Gartner) that can already accommodate all requirements? We think that this way, we will accomplish such a project in much less time. Please advise?</b> |
| Answer             | The vendor can propose already building Asset Management system, meeting the requirement of RFP, however, the vendor should certify that the system is open source without any additional licensing requirements and provide source code with full use/customization rights to the client (HNEC).                 |
| <b>Question 2.</b> | <b>You are requesting an open source Database such as MySQL, PostgreSQL, MariaDB or MongoDB. Can we propose a non-open source database, that is free for use with our prebuild software?</b>  |
| Answer             | Please note that open source database is a mandatory requirement from the client. You can provide prebuild software as long as the software can be customized and the source code and the software is available under opensource terms without any additional licensing requirement.                              |
| <b>Question 3.</b> | <b>Based on the training requirement, the number of users that will be using the software is 8 end users in addition to administrator. How many administrators do you have?</b>   |
| Answer             | The client will have a maximum of 03 administrators.  |
