<p>Does UNDP Iraq verify the bidders' submitted Financial Audit Statements from relative responsible governmental authorities (i.e. if the bidder is an Iraqi Co., then his financial audit statements to be verified from Iraqi local responsible governmental authorities)? We raised this inquiry as we are strongly believe that this is a very important fraud's mitigation measure for any bidder -if any- that may submit non actual financial audit statements. This fraud's mitigation measure is vital to ensure fair, transparent and equal opportunities' competition for all potential bidders; especially that the tax amount that will be paid to the tax department is around (3.30 to 3.50%) of the accepted contract value which will affect significantly the cost and will be reflected directly on the priced offers of potential bidders.</p>	<p>Please refer to Section 4: Evaluation Criteria</p> <p>UNDP shall verify the financial capacity of the bidder and has the authority to seek references from concerned parties & banks on the bidder' financial standing. UNDP had the right to reject any bid if submitted by a contractor whom investigation leads to a result that he is not Financially capable and/ or had serious financial problems.</p>
<p>As per ITB requirements (section 4 - Evaluation Criteria - Financial Standing), it is mentioned clearly at the end of the ITB's financial requirements an important note stated literally "For JV/Consortium/Association, all Parties cumulatively should meet requirement". This is meaning that the JV parties cumulatively (collectively) must meet requirement, while it is not meaning at all that each party of the JV must meet the requirement regardless their roles and responsibilities.
