1. BACKGROUND

The UNDP Sustainable Land Management in the Qaraoun Catchment (SLMQ) Project aims at embedding sustainability considerations in land use planning and development activities in the Qaraoun Catchment. The project is funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF) and is implemented in partnership with the Ministry of Environment in Lebanon. The project is intended to reshape land and natural resource management to (i) alleviate land degradation, (ii) maintain existing ecosystem services and (iii) improve livelihoods in the Qaraoun Catchment.

The project objectives will be achieved by developing institutional tools upstream at national level which will provide the Ministry of the Environment (MoE) and the Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) as well as

related agencies such as the Council for Development and Reconstruction (CDR), the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities, the Bekaa Governorate, and District Administrations and Municipalities in the districts of Zahle, Rachaya, and West Bekaa with the know-how, means and mechanisms for promoting sustainable land use as in the best interest of the land owners, farmers and communities as well as the nation.

The implementation of the proposed project will have an immediate environmental benefit, through the increased management efficiency of arable land and rangelands and the expansion of the area under forests through land use plans, buffer zones, and riparian strips. It will also contribute to the restoration of natural productivity and conservation of the habitats of various plant and animal species and valuable ecosystems and will secure migratory bird pathways.

It is in this context that the SLMQ project is seeking the services of an expert to support the project in the establishment of rainfed vineyards on degraded and/or abandoned terraces through the revival of old, local and multipurpose grape cultivars (Vitis vinifera L.) using modern cultivation techniques in combination with medicinal, aromatic and culinary plants in the districts of Zahle, Rashaya and West Bekaa.

This assignment is expected to allow the project team to implement the rehabilitation of degraded terraces in various areas of the Bekaa to restore their agriculture potential following sustainable land management practices and taking into account economic opportunities identified for these areas. The consultant is also expected to promote best practices recommended for the establishment of such cultivations aiming at replicating the impact of the project.

This consultancy is divided into the following tasks:

- Task 1 Assessment of pre-selected areas for rehabilitation
- Task 2 Development of BoQs for the establishment of vineyards of selected sites
- **Task 3** Dissemination of best practices and technology transfer through targeted hands-on trainings
- **Task 4** Provide technical support during implementation.

2. SCOPE OF WORK, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPOSED ANALYTICAL WORK

The tasks mentioned below shall be performed in close cooperation with the UNDP/SLMQ team. It is understood that the Consultant shall perform all the services/work as necessary to fulfill the objectives of the Consultancy Contract.

The requested services shall build on previous work undertaken by the project to identify degraded agricultural lands and specifically degraded and/or abandoned terraces in the districts of Zahle, Rashaya and West Bekaa.

Bachelor's degree in agricultural engineering or closely related.

At least 10 years of work experience on the preferred field of viticulture management and vineyard establishment in general.

- Experience in working with government agencies (centrally and locally) is an asset;
- Proven knowledge of the Bekaa vineyards ecosystems;
- Experience with UN or international donor project(s) is an asset

IIV. Competencies:

- Proficiency in English and Arabic languages.
- Demonstrable analytical skills and report writing skills;
- Good management and communication skills.

Travel:

<u>All envisaged travel costs must be included in the financial proposal</u>. This includes all travel to join duty station/repatriation travel. In general, UNDP should not accept travel costs exceeding those of an economy class ticket. Should the IC wish to travel on a higher class he/she should do so using their own resources.

In the case of unforeseeable travel, payment of travel costs including tickets, lodging and terminal expenses should be agreed upon, between the respective business unit and Individual Consultant, prior to travel and will be reimbursed.
