- Knowledge and skill in sign language interpreters who can interpret/translate in either or both English and Nepali language;
- Having a good communication and listening skills;

III. Required Languages:

• Should have a good command over English and Nepali language.

Note:

- a) Applicants of 62 years or more require full medical examination and statement of fitness to work to engage in the consultancy
- b) The candidate has to be an independent consultant (If the candidate is engaged with any organization, the organization employing the candidate will be issued with a Reimbursable Loan Agreement (RLA) to release the employee for the consultancy with UNDP.)
- c) Due to sheer number of applicants, the procurement unit will contact only competitively selected consultant.

# 5. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

## • Contracts based on daily fee

The financial proposal will specify the daily fee, travel expenses and per diems quoted in separate line items, and payments are made to the Individual Consultant based on the number of days worked.

## Travel;

<u>All envisaged travel costs must be included in the financial proposal</u>. This includes all travel to join duty station/repatriation travel. In general, UNDP should not accept travel costs exceeding those of an economy class ticket. Should the IC wish to travel on a higher class he/she should do so using their own resources.

In the case of unforeseeable travel, payment of travel costs including tickets, lodging and terminal expenses should be agreed upon, between the respective business unit and Individual Consultant, prior to travel and will be reimbursed.

# 6. EVALUATION

Individual consultants will be evaluated based on the following methodologies:

Cumulative analysis

When using this weighted scoring method, the award of the contract should be made to the individual consultant whose offer has been evaluated and determined as: a) responsive/compliant/acceptable, and

b) Having received the highest score out of a pre-determined set of weighted technical and financial criteria specific to the solicitation.

\* Technical Criteria weight; 70%

\* Financial Criteria weight; 30%

# Terms of References (TOR) Sign Language Interpreter

# i. Organizational Context and Project Description

The primary objective of the assignment is for the outsourcing of the individual to facilitate or provide skilled sign language interpreter to the UNDP Nepal office, as in when required basis

such as during meetings, conferences, workshops, video production etc. as per the UNDP requirements. The sign language interpretation is requested for both in English and Nepali.

# iii. Requirements

- 1) The individual should have bachelor's degree in Social Science, Arts or any other related discipline with 2 years of work experience.
- 2) The individual should be skillful in sign language interpreters who can interpret/translate in either or both English and Nepali language.
- 3) The sign language interpreters should have a good communication and listening skills;
- 4) High level of understanding in English/Nepali or in both;
- 5) At least 2 years of experience of providing sing language interpretation services.

# iv. Operating Procedures

- 1) The individual will be provided with long term agreement rates (LTA) for the sign language interpreter services;
- 2) The individual will be contacted by UNDP office as in when required basis for the facilitation or assistance of sign language interpreters for the meetings, workshops, conferences etc.;

# v. Status:

The Contractor shall be considered as having legal status of an independent Contractor and shall not be considered in any respect as being a member of the United Nations. The rights and obligations of the Contractor are strictly limited in articles mentioned in Terms of Reference. Accordingly, the Contractor shall not be entitled to any benefit except as expressly mentioned in Terms of Reference and the agreement.

# vi. Payment:

The payment to the Contractor will be upon the completion of the assignment basis upon receipt of the invoices.

The initial duration of the LTA is for one years with a possibility of extension up to maximum 3 years period.
